**MOTION FOR CONTINUANCE**

Advanced TelCom Group, Inc., hereinafter referred to as "Applicant," by its attorney, and pursuant to Arizona Corporation Commission Title 14, Chapter 2, Article 11, Rules 14-2-1104, 14-2-1105 and 14-2-1108, hereby respectfully requests that the Arizona Corporation Commission, hereinafter referred to as "Commission", issue an order in response to this motion, for an extension of time in which to file certain information requested by Commission Procedural Order dated September 19, 2000 (the "September 19, 2000 Procedural Order"). In support of this motion, the Applicant shows the following:

1. On February 29, 2000, Applicant filed for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Provide Competitive Telecommunications Service and Competitive Classification to the Services Applicant intends to provide.
2. On July 5, 2000, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff filed a Staff Report.
3. On July 14, 2000, a Procedural Order was issued setting the matter for hearing and requiring Applicant to publish notice of its application.
4. On September 19, 2000, the Commission issued the September 19, 2000 Procedural Order.
5. On October 9, 2000, Applicant filed an Affidavit of Publication with the Commission.

6. Applicant hereby respectfully requests the Commission grant an order for a sixty (60) day extension of time in which to provide responses to unnumbered ordering paragraphs three, four, five, six and seven of the September 19, 2000 Procedural Order, and grant such other relief as it deems necessary and proper.
