INSUFFICIENCY LETTER

Dear Mr. Levie:

In reference to the above mentioned application filed on February 11, 2005, this letter is to inform you that the application has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code. The deficiencies are:

1. Please provide a copy of the Arizona Department of Water Resources' Analysis of Adequate Water Supply for the proposed service territory.
2. Please provide an itemized cost breakdown of the Phase 1 water facilities costs to the Company (estimated at \$239,000), necessary to serve the proposed CC&N extension area.
3. Please provide a request for service from each of the affected property owners.
4. Please provide a map of the requested service territory with an identification of the respective property owners requesting service.
5. The Yavapai County Franchise agreement provided does not include all of the proposed extension area. Please provide a copy of an amended Franchise agreement that includes Section 24, Township 18 North, Range 3 West.
6. Please provide a copy of the Arizona Department of Environmental Quality's approval to construct for the proposed service territory.

7. Since the CC&N extension area includes State land, please provide evidence of the Arizona State Land Department's approval.

Staff would like to use this opportunity to bring the following to your attention:

- Pursuant to the Arizona Administrative Code ("A.A.C.") R-14-2-411(C), upon meeting sufficiency requirements, the Commission has 150 calendar days for its substantive review. This includes conducting a hearing and preparing Opinion and Order to present to the Commission at an Open Meeting; and
- Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-411(C)(3), Staff may terminate an application if the applicant does not remedy all deficiencies within 60 calendar days of the notice of deficiency.
