PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On October 23, 2003, Arizona Public Service Company ("APS") filed an application requesting a declaratory order finding that its past and present procedures for bill estimation either are exempt from or comply with the requirements of A.A.C. R14-2-102 and R14-2-1612 ("Application for Declaratory Order").

On September 9, 2004, Avis Read ("Complainant"), on her own behalf and on behalf of a class of customers of APS filed a complaint ("Complaint") against APS.

On November 2, 2004, a Procedural Order was issued consolidating these matters and setting procedural dates.

On January 27, 2005, APS requested a telephonic procedural conference to discuss a procedural issue.

On January 28, 2005, a telephonic procedural conference was held with the parties. APS requested a short suspension of the procedural schedule for one week, in order to allow it and the

1 parties to discuss settlement of these consolidated matters. No party opposed the request, and the  
2 request was granted. A telephonic procedural conference was scheduled for Friday, February 4, 2005  
3 at 1:30 p.m. for an update on the status of discussions.

4 On February 4, 2005, the telephonic procedural conference was held and the parties indicated  
5 that they would like additional time for settlement discussions.

6 On February 17, 2005, a procedural conference was held. The parties indicated that they  
7 would like additional time for settlement discussions.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED a procedural conference shall be held on February 28, 2005,  
9 at 10:00 a.m. or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West  
10 Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, at which time the parties will report on whether there is a  
11 settlement and a procedural schedule will be set.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized  
13 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding.

14 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive  
15 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


