
Based on many of the recent articles and information being introduced, we feel that it is important to provide our comments directly to the Committee. We have and continue to strongly oppose this proposed route. It is our understanding that many of our neighbors throughout this corridor have similar positions. Our primary opposition with the line continues to be the possible adverse health conditions, particularly those that are linked to children and the negative impact on property values.

SRP had given us some optimism when they identified the “Southern Alignment” along Interstate 8 as their “preferred route”. Quite honestly, this route appears to be the most logical when you consider population density, area considered for future development, and the impacts on the families and community of Casa Grande. We understand the need for additional electrical power. However, we are very concerned that the comments and positions provided by the residents throughout the public forum and meeting process are falling on “deaf ears”.

We remain optimistic that the Committee understands the impact these lines will have on the existing neighborhoods, schools and churches and that you will recommend an alignment that could be constructed in areas that are primarily farmland, less densely populated, and could be considered and planned for by future development. This is regarding in considering Sova's proposal as an alternate route. I have several concerns.

- ① How are you going to notify the residents who live in Sova's proposed area? A public notice in the paper won't work. (for the hearings). Be fair, do a mailing to the property owners.
- ② Don't we, the residents along Sova's route have the right to give alternate routes? If not, why not? What about our concerns & objections? A better route in the south is not Barnes. It will be Miller Rd. Miller Rd alignment affects less people.
- ③ Why should the residents along Sova's proposed route be forced to accept a route without giving alternate routes.
- ④ Are you willing to delay the project because of BLM?
- ⑤ What happens if BLM rejects Sova's proposal?
- ⑥ Why should the residents have to pay thru higher electric bills to cover the delays & extra expense of studies (because of BLM).

⑨ My area doesn't have the luxury to have a property owner who is willing to pay for everything (including a bus for the public comment night). There is some people in my area who feel you all have been brought. There are also others who feel how can we compete against SOVA.

⑩ When will it stop sending routes down my way. If SOVA's route is allowed, my neighbor lot is useless (the S.W. corner of Hidden Valley Rd + Barnes, along with everything on the South side - all fronted). By the time you combine SRP, APS, Set back required by Pinal County + required distance from washes required by Pinal County you have eliminated them.

With SOVA's proposal, I will be less than 300ft from it. If a 3rd CEC is allowed, it's in my property. If a 4th CEC is allowed, it's over my house. Yet SOVA doesn't considered my area a develop area.

Dear Chairman Woodall and Members of the Committee:

We are writing this letter to express our vigorous opposition to the proposed power line routes running to the north of Casa Grande. We are the owners of 100 acres of currently vacant land located along the east side of Peart Rd. beginning ½ mile south of McCartney Rd. A final subdivision plat, known as Mission Ranch, has been approved by the City of Casa Grande for this property that contains 344 lots. Eventually it is estimated that there will be over 1,000 residents living in Mission Ranch. The northern boundary of Mission Ranch is the southern boundary of the gas line right-of-way.

Given the proximity to Mission Ranch and a large number of other approved and/or planned residential communities along the Northern Alignment, we were shocked that SRP would even consider running this huge power line through an area that will soon be one of the most densely populated areas in Pinal County. We request that the siting Committee stop this potential disaster. There are a number of reasons that this line should be avoided.

There are literally thousands of existing residents that live within a half-mile to a mile of SRP's proposed Northern Alignment. In fact, during its testimony, SRP admitted that there are nearly 600 dwelling units within a mere 1/8th of a mile of its proposed power line alignment right now. This number is set to multiply exponentially in the very near future, as the land in this area is some of the farthest along in the development cycle in all of the exploding Pinal County area.

The fact that this route is even being considered or proposed is astonishing when you look at SRP's testimony regarding the number of homes within an 1/8th of a mile of its other proposed alignment segments. When you look at these numbers you typically see that maybe ten or twenty dwelling units will be within a 1/8th of a mile of the line but here you have at least 30 times as many dwelling units presently existing.

The Preferred Alignment that is favored by the City of Casa Grande transits areas that do not have the number of dwelling units and that are thus far unplanned. Placing the lines in the south will allow development to incorporate the lines rather than being destroyed by the lines and makes sound sense for the future of the area.

We thank you and the other Members of the Committee for your consideration of these matters. This area is the residential heart of the City of Casa Grande and we ask that the Committee recognize this fact and only approve a line running to the south of the City of Casa Grande.
