PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

By Procedural Order dated March 16, 2005, the hearing in the above-captioned consolidated matter was set for June 16, 2005.

On March 21, 2005, Coronado Utilities, Inc. ("Coronado" or "Company") filed a Request for Continuance of Hearing asking that the hearing date be reset for June 29, 2005 or June 30, 2005, because its counsel is scheduled to appear at a previously set Commission hearing beginning on June 16, 2005. In its Request, the Company reports that Commission Utilities Division Staff has no objection to the Request. The Company has agreed to extend the application's timeclock through September 7, 2005, if its request is granted.<sup>1</sup>

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing in the above-captioned matter currently set for June 16, 2005 shall be rescheduled to be held on **June 29, 2005, at 10:00 a.m.** or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, **Room 222**, 400 West Congress St., Tucson, Arizona 85701.

<sup>1</sup> The timeclock deadline based upon the application date is August 9, 2005. September 7, 2005, is the Commission's next regularly scheduled Open Meeting following August 9, 2005.


1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions of the March 16, 2005 Procedural

8 any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.


