Public Notice Of Hearing On The Application Of Southland Sanitation Co. For A Deletion Of A Portion Of Its Certificate Of Convenience And Necessity Docket No. SW-02390A-05-0097 On February 14, 2005, Southland Sanitation Co. ("Applicant") filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to delete a portion of its service territory under its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide wastewater utility service. If the application is granted, Applicant will no longer be the provider of wastewater service to the proposed deletion area, and the Commission will no longer set rates or mandate rules for providing service. Pursuant to the application, wastewater service within the deleted area will be provided by the City of Sierra Vista. The application is available for inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission in Phoenix, at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona, and Tucson, at 400 West Congress St. Suite 218, Tucson, Arizona and at the office of the Applicant, 2730 East Broadway Blvd., Suite 135, Tucson, Arizona. The Commission will hold a hearing on this matter beginning June 16, 2005, at 10:00 a.m., at the Commission's offices, Room 222, 400 West Congress Street, Tucson, Arizona. Public comment will be taken on the first day of the hearing. The law provides for an open public hearing at which, under appropriate circumstances, interested persons may intervene in the proceedings and participate as a party. You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding. Intervention will be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-405, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before June 1, 2005. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to Applicants or their counsel and to all parties of record. The motion must, at the minimum, contain the following: 1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different from that of the intervenor. 2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor's interest in the proceeding (e.g., a customer or potential customer of the Applicant, a shareholder of the Applicant, etc.). 3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been mailed to the Applicant or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case. The granting of an intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and providing public comment on the applications. You will not receive further notice of this proceeding unless you request it. If you have any questions about these applications, or want further information on intervention, you may contact the Consumer Services Section of the Commission at 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, or call 1-800-222-7000. The Commission does not discriminate on the basis of disability in admission to its public meetings.
