TO RESPOND TO JOHNSON  
UTILITIES COMPANY'S MOTION TO

Diversified Water Utilities, Inc. ("Diversified") hereby moves to extend the time to respond to the Motion to Continue the Proceedings in the above captioned matters filed by Johnson Utilities Company ("JUC"). The response is due April 29, 2005 (today). The motion was provided at 4:45 p.m. by email on Friday, April 22, 2005 after Counsel for Diversified had left for the day. During this week, undersigned Counsel for Diversified has served as arbitrator on a hearing, traveled to Tucson, been in meetings and otherwise been unavailable to devote sufficient attention to preparing a Response. In addition, the office

1 computer system is undergoing an upgrade this week and is totally off line commencing  
2 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, April 28, 2005 until the upgrade is completed (lasting through  
3 Friday and possibly all weekend). Finally, the President of Diversified is out of town and  
4 generally unavailable until Monday, May 2, 2005.

6 For the foregoing reasons, Diversified respectfully requests a short extension  
7 of time to file its response to JUC's Motion to Continue until 4:00 p.m. Wednesday, May 4,  
8 2005 and that time for JUC to file a reply be similarly extended. Such an extension will not  
9 prejudice the parties as Administrative Law Judge Dwight Nodes has already suspended  
10 discovery and all other procedural requirements in the case. Counsel for Diversified has  
11 contacted counsel for Staff and JUC regarding this motion and both have indicated that they  
12 do not oppose the request of Diversified.
