Dear Mr. McNeil:

On June 4, 2004, SBC Long Distance, Inc. ("SBC Long Distance") filed an application for an expansion of its authority to provide interexchange resale services under its existing Certificate of Convenience and Necessity granted in Decision No. 61227 to include the authority to provide facilities-based interLATA, interexchange telecommunications service on a statewide basis within the State of Arizona. The Commission approved the Application on May 3, 2005 ("Decision").

In the Decision, the Commission conditioned the granting of facilities-based interexchange authority on two requirements: that SBC Long Distance shall file tariffs conforming to the tariffs proposed in the application within 365 days of the Decision; and that SBC Long Distance shall procure and docket proof of a performance bond in the amount of \$100,000.00.

The purpose of this filing is to notify the Arizona Corporation Commission that SBC Long Distance has met the two conditions ordered in the Decision. On May 5, 2005, in a Compliance filing made by SBC Long Distance, LLC, conforming interexchange tariffs were filed with the Commission (A.C.C. Tariff No. 9 filed under advice letter no. 184, and A.C.C. Tariff No. 10 filed under advice letter no. 181).

Also, enclosed with a compliance filing in May 5, 2005 in Docket Nos. T-03346A-04-0911 and T-03811A-04-0911, SBC Long Distance filed a rider to performance bond no. 104467254, which is already of file with the Commission. This bond rider increased the existing bond amount from \$125,000 to \$235,000 to meet the bond requirements ordered by the Commission in Docket No. T-03346A-03-0844 (ordering a performance bond in the amount of

\$125,000), in this Docket No. T-03346A-04-0413 (ordering a performance bond in the amount of \$100,000) and in Docket Nos. T-03346A-04-0911 and T-03811A-04-0911 (ordering a performance bond in the amount of \$10,000). This bond rider also changes the principal name on the bond from SBC Long Distance, Inc. to SBC Long Distance, LLC d/b/a SBC Long Distance.

Based on the filings described above, SBC Long Distance has met all of the conditions identified in the Decision, and asks for an acknowledgement from the Commission that SBCLD has met the conditions necessary to initiate facilities-based interLATA, interexchange telecommunications service on a statewide basis within the State of Arizona.
