The only local customers that Matrix will serve initially will be those being transferred from Global Crossing to Matrix pursuant to the pending transaction. Therefore the proposed tariff is an adopted version of Global Crossing Local Services, Inc.'s approved Arizona tariff which contains rates which are currently being offered to the customers being transferred.

2. Please indicate why you believe that your range of rates is just and reasonable using a competitive market analysis. Your analysis may contain publicly available example of rates charged by the incumbent or other carriers for similar services or any other information that you believe demonstrates that your actual rates are just and reasonable. Please include any supporting materials. As indicated above, the Matrix tariff was adopted from the Global Crossing tariff currently effective as approved by the Commission.
