Re: Adelphia Telecommunications, Inc. Interexchange Carrier Market Exit

Dear Corporation Commission:

Adelphia Telecommunications, Inc. (“Adelphia”) made a business decision to stop selling and providing long distance services. When this decision was made, Adelphia initiated an exhaustive attempt to sell the customer base to an existing long distance provider, unfortunately we were not successful.

The company currently provides long distance services to approximately 240 telephone numbers in Arizona. Adelphia’s long distance service is provided via a resell arrangement through a third party provider; Adelphia has no long distance facilities in the state. Adelphia holds no customer deposits for any Arizona customers.

Adelphia requests that the Commission issue an order withdrawing its certification to provide long distance services in the state and canceling any tariffs on file. Adelphia currently holds a certification obtained in Docket T 003837A. Customers will be given a minimum of 30 days’ notice of discontinuance of service. Attached is an example of the notification letter sent to customers.

Within 20 days of the sending of this letter, Adelphia will provide public legal notice in every county affected by its plan to discontinue long distance services. At this time that includes all the counties in Arizona: Yuma, Maricopa, Mohave, Coconino, Navajo, Apache, Yavapai, La Paz, Pinal, Pima, Santa Cruz, Cochise, Graham, Green Lee, and Gila.

Dear Adelphia Long Distance Customer,

Adelphia Telecommunications, Inc. ("Adelphia") will discontinue long distance telephone service in your state on July 28, 2005.

Our records indicate we provide you with intrastate and or interstate long distance calling capability. In order to continue the ability to make long distance telephone calls you must select and initiate service with an alternate long distance telephone service provider by July 28, 2005. If you have not completed the migration to a new provider by July 28, 2005 your long distance capability would be restricted and long distance calls will be blocked.

Adelphia cannot suggest a new long distance provider, companies providing long distance in your area can be found in your local telephone book.
