

 PUBLIC NOTICE BY SBC TELECOM, INC. AND SBC LONG DISTANCE, LLC. On December 17, 2004, SBC Telecom, Inc. (SBC Telecom) and SBC Long Distance, Inc. ("SBC Long Distance") filed a joint application and petition with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") in Docket No. T-033464-04-0911 and Docket No. T-03011A-04-0911 to approve their proposed reorganization, explaining that SBC Telecom, a local phone service provider, will combine business operations with its affiliate SBC Long Distance, LLC. On May 3, 2005, the Commission approved the reorganization. As a result of the internal change, SBC Telecom will cancel its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CCAN) which was filed on June 13, 2000 in Decision No. 62645 and discontinue service in its own name to customers in Arizona because it has transferred its assets, liabilities, and all operations to SBC Long Distance. SBC Long Distance will be the single SBC affiliate to provide re-sold and facilities-based long distance and local exchange telecommunications services in Arizona. The transition of service from SBC Telecom to SBC Long Distance will have no impact on customer service. Customers will not incur any charges related to the transfer of service to SBC Long Distance. Current customers of SBC Telecom will continue to receive the same local services with the same rates, features, terms and conditions as they currently have with SBC Telecom. The change will happen automatically with no action required on the part of SBC Telecom customers. A.C.C. R14-2-1107 provides that customers of SBC Telecom may be serviced by a service provider of their choice, and customers may elect to discontinue service without prejudice or regard to contractual obligations and have access to alternative utilities that provide local exchange and long distance services. For SBC Telecom customers that choose to discontinue service, your advances, prepayments or other funds owed will be credited to your account or will be refunded via a check. 65385-May 23, 2005
