

EXTENSION OF TIME. (DOCKET NO. T-03883A-00-0366)

On July 3, 2001, Local Gateway Exchange, Inc. ("LGE") submitted correspondence requesting an extension of time to comply with one condition in the decision granting LGE authority to provide facilities-based and resold local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services (Decision No. 63492, March 30, 2001).

LGE's CC&N was conditioned on: 1) the Company filing a performance bond for \$100,000 within 90 days of the Commission's decision or 30 days prior to the provision of service, whichever comes first. LGE requested an extension of time to comply with this compliance requirement and was granted an extension until June 30, 2001. LGE is now requesting another extension to August 15, 2001. Staff has no objections to this request.

In your letter of non-compliance dated May 3, 2001, Local Gateway Exchange, Inc. (LGEI) was advised that it had not met certain compliance requirements ordered in the above referenced Decision. LGEI was ordered specifically to complete the following compliance action by April 30, 2001:

Compliance Action: File with the Commission proof of performance bond in the amount of \$100,000.

LGEI had requested and was granted an extension to June 30, 2001. During this time we have had difficulty finding a company locally to provide this performance bond. Upon LGEI's request, Marta Kallaberg faxed today a listing of companies that have provided this service to other companies. We will follow up with these companies and see no problems in obtaining a performance bond with one of them; however, due to the time needed in order to send requested information and obtain the performance bond, LGEI is requesting an extension for this remaining action item to be August 15, 2001.
