PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 19, 2004, Oak Creek Utility Corporation ("Oak Creek" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a rate increase in water and wastewater rates in Docket No. WS-02061A-04-0835. Concurrently, Oak Creek filed an application for authority to issue promissory note(s) and other evidences of indebtedness in Docket No. WS-02061A-04-0836. By Procedural Order issued April 12, 2005, the dockets were consolidated.

According to the April 11, 2005 Staff Report, 13 customer contacts were received in opposition to the proposed rate increase, representing 42 percent of Oak Creek's 31 customers. Due to the number of customer contacts received by the Commission, a Procedural Order was issued on April 20, 2005, scheduling a public comment hearing in the Oak Creek area to receive customer input regarding this matter. The public comment hearing was conducted in Sedona, Arizona on May 5, 2005.

The necessity for the public comment hearing held on May 5, 2005 represents an "extraordinary event" that requires an extension of the time clock. Therefore, in order to allow the

2 Commission, the time period in this matter shall be extended for 45 days.

3 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED the time period for issuance of a final Decision in this matter
4 shall be extended for 45 days for good cause pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-103.B.11.e.ii.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may subsequently rescind,
6 alter, amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order.


