IX. Reporting Requirements

TEP Shall submit the following information to the Commission on an annual basis:

- A. A List of all Extraordinary Circumstances excusing TEP's compliance with the Code of Conduct and a report explaining the nature, cause, and duration of each incident.

Response: There are no Extraordinary Circumstances to report.

- B. A report detailing the costs associated with all nontariffed transactions between TEP and its Competitive Electric Affiliates, with the associated costs reported separately for each business activity and for each transaction.

Response: There were no nontariffed transactions between TEP and its competitive electric affiliate to report.

- C. A report detailing how many non-Standard Offer Service customers were provided metering services or meter reading services pursuant to R14-2-1615.B and how many Electric Service Providers received consolidated billing services from TEP pursuant to R14-2-1615.B.

Response: TEP has not had any Direct Access customers that received metering services since the last report was made on April 13, 2004. TEP has one Energy Service Provider certified in TEP's Service Area, however, this ESP has not received any consolidated billing.
