PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On December 15, 2004, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Arthur B. Cooper and Linda Ebinger-Cooper (collectively "Respondents"), in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of membership interests and/or investment contracts.

The Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On December 29, 2004, a request for hearing was filed for Respondents.

On January 3, 2005, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled.

On February 3, 2005, pursuant to the Commission's Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was held with both the Division and Respondent represented by counsel. After a discussion concerning the possible number of witnesses and the evidence, it was agreed that a hearing should be scheduled in May, 2005. By Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled for May 17, 2005.

On April 28, 2005, following a teleconference with the presiding Administrative Law Judge, the parties filed a stipulation to continue the hearing.

1 Accordingly, the hearing should be continued.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the hearing shall be continued from May 17, 2005, to
3 June 29, 2005, at 9:30 a.m., at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix,
4 Arizona.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the parties shall also set aside June 30 and July 7, 2005 for
6 additional days of hearing, if necessary.

7 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Division and the Respondents shall exchange witness
8 lists and copies of exhibits by 4:00 p.m. on June 8, 2005, with courtesy copies also provided to the
9 presiding Administrative Law Judge.


