This notice will inform you that Verizon Select Services, Inc. has not met certain compliance requirements ordered by the Commission in the above-referenced Decision. In that Decision, the Commission conditioned approval of the application on Verizon Select Services, Inc. filing certain documents with the Commission within a specific time period as described on the enclosed Compliance Delinquencies Report.

As a result of this non-compliance, the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity did not issue to Verizon Select Services, Inc. and is void. If Verizon Select Services, Inc. intends to provide service in the future within Arizona, it must file a new application for a certificate of convenience and necessity.

COMPLIANCE ACTION: Certificate is conditioned on, and the tariffs are approved on an interim basis, subject to the Company filing, within 18 months of the date the Company first provides service following certification, Fair Value Rate Base information which shall include a dollar amount representing the total revenue for the first twelve months of telecommunications service provided to Arizona customers following certification, adjusted to reflect the maximum rates that the Company requests in its tariff. This adjusted total revenue figure could be calculated as the number of units sold for all services offered times the maximum charge per unit. Also file Fair Value Rate Base information detailing the total actual operating expenses for the first twelve months of telecommunications service provided to Arizona customers by the Company following certification. Also file information which includes a description and value of all assets, including plant, equipment, and office supplies to be used to provide telecommunications service to Arizona customers for the first twelve months following Certification. The Company's failure to meet this condition to file sufficient information for a fair value finding and analysis and recommendation of permanent tariffs should result in the expiration of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity and the tariffs.
