





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Technical Workshop 5 was held at 8:40 a.m., May 22,  
2001, at 3898 Wadsworth Boulevard, Lakewood, Colorado,  
before Facilitators Hagood Bellinger and John Schultz.

APPEARANCES

(As noted in the transcript.)

1                   MR. ZULEVIC: Well, it is, in that we're  
2 talking about splitters, and whether or not they should  
3 be provided on a port-at-a-time basis. Do those  
4 splitters that you will be deploying, are they outboard  
5 type of splitters? Are they also, as you represented,  
6 your CO-based DSLAM, an integrated type or hard-wired  
7 splitter?

8                   MR. HUBBARD: Mike, I haven't seen any of  
9 the actual installs in the field. The pictures I have  
10 seen, and the drawings I have seen, they are  
11 amphenol-connected together, the same as in the Central  
12 Office. That's my understanding of it. There's no  
13 actual appearance of wires.

14                   MR. ZULEVIC: Now, I would just like to  
15 add that, to the extent that Qwest does deploy outboard  
16 type of splitters, we would agree with the AT&T  
17 position that we should be able to have access to those  
18 on a port-at-a-time basis, whether they be located in  
19 the Central Office or whether they are at the remote  
20 terminal.

21                   MR. BELLINGER: But the issue is -- let  
22 me clarify this issue. You don't provide outboard  
23 splitters, am I right?

24                   MR. HUBBARD: Yes. That is our  
25 contention. We do not provide outboard splitters. All

1 of the splitters are on a one-to-one basis. One port  
2 DSLAM for one splitter. We don't have extras in there.

3 MR. BELLINGER: Okay.

4 MR. ZULEVIC: Well, so we're saying that  
5 you don't have the ability to provide them technically  
6 on a one-at-a-time basis because of the way it's  
7 configured.

8 MR. HUBBARD: That is correct.

9 MR. WILSON: But theoretically you could  
10 provide a shelf at a time if it's connecterized.

11 MR. HUBBARD: You could do anything  
12 theoretically. I mean --

13 MR. WILSON: Well, I mean practically. I  
14 mean, you could lease the existing splitters you have a  
15 shelf at a time if the CLEC had a connector of the same  
16 type.

17 MR. HUBBARD: Theoretically, you would  
18 strand any availability out of the DSLAM to provide  
19 service if you did that.

20 MR. WILSON: Well, if you provision a  
21 shelf more than you would -- I mean, it's just --  
22 that's just a provisioning question. In other words,  
23 if you don't order more shelves of DSLAMs, then that's  
24 true. If you order another shelf of splitters, that's  
25 not true.

1                   MR. HUBBARD: I guess that's a true  
2 statement, Ken. I don't know. Do you have a question  
3 in there?

4                   MR. WILSON: No. I was just, given that  
5 we initially -- my initial understanding was that the  
6 splitter was built onto the same board. Now, that's  
7 not true. We have come to where the splitters are on  
8 one shelf and DSLAMs on another shelf, and they are  
9 connecterized between the two. It leads to maybe not a  
10 port at a time, but a shelf at a time, such that if a  
11 CLEC had enough volume -- say if there are 24 splitters  
12 on a shelf, if you are running 24 orders a day, for  
13 instance, it would be a shelf of splitters a day.

14                  MR. BELLINGER: Okay. I think we are  
15 pretty much at impasse. I don't know if there's  
16 anything to add.

17                  MS. DOBERNECK: Actually, I just -- I  
18 don't have a question. I had one thing to add.  
19 Getting back to this outboard splitter, the  
20 unintegrated DSLAM splitter. And the reason it  
21 matters, from our perspective, is that there is a  
22 recent order that came out of the Texas PUC, in the  
23 SWBT/AT&T arbitration, in which the commission made  
24 clear that where you have a standalone splitter or  
25 splitter that is not integrated with the DSLAM, that

EVENING SESSION

(6:10 p.m.)

JUDGE RENDAHL: Before the break, I think we finished as much as we could with loop issue 4, and the next issue is loop issue 5, which is a Covad issue involving Colorado xDSL FOC trials.

MS. DOBERNECK: Yes, we had raised -- actually, well, this is -- involves our modification of testimony, but let me give a little background. We had raised here and elsewhere our concerns about Qwest loop delivery interval. And in response, Qwest implemented an FOC trial, I think Jean referenced this in her opening presentation, in order to see if they had failed to -- there to see if Qwest altered its procedures it could provide a meaningful FOC in order to improve or enhance or address CLEC concerns about loop delivery.

JUDGE RENDAHL: And now just before you go on, FOC is firm order confirmation?

MS. DOBERNECK: Yes.

JUDGE RENDAHL: Okay.

MS. DOBERNECK: And so through the data reconciliation process where we have -- part of -- part of the trial was going to a 72 hour FOC as part of the process to see if the -- if the interval could be improved. As a result of that trial, we have agreed to

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1 support Qwest in going to the ROC and moving the current  
2 FOC of 24 hours to 72 hours.

3 JUDGE RENDAHL: Okay.

4 MS. DOBERNECK: And we have also, and this  
5 goes to the modification of Ms. Cutcher's testimony,  
6 withdrawn or we will be withdrawing our testimony  
7 regarding the FOC trial and the loop installation  
8 interval as well as MC-3, which relates to the FOC  
9 trial. So we consider that particular issue closed  
10 although subject to review at the conclusion of the OSS  
11 testing as far as how Qwest performs on the PO-5 and  
12 OP-3 measurements. And I believe I got those correct,  
13 but correct me if I'm wrong.

14 JUDGE RENDAHL: Okay. Is there any comment  
15 from Qwest or other parties on that point?

16 MS. LISTON: Part of the FOC trial, and we  
17 had some discussion off line regarding SGATs, and right  
18 now the SGAT has the trial in the SGAT. What we will  
19 propose to do is the language that's in the SGAT right  
20 now referring to the trial will be modified to be part  
21 of the overall procedures associated with FOC for DSL  
22 services.

23 So basically what we had done in the SGAT was  
24 to put a placeholder describing the trial in. We  
25 labeled it as part of the -- as being Colorado trial,

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1 because it strictly was only associated with the trial  
2 at that point. We did it as a placeholder so that we  
3 wouldn't lose the issue on a going forward basis and  
4 that all parties knew that Qwest was still actively  
5 pursuing the change in the FOC. What we envision  
6 happening is that we would then take Colorado, the words  
7 Colorado trial, and strike them from the SGAT. And then  
8 in -- let me just find that SGAT reference for you.

9 MR. KOPTA: It's Section 9.2.4.3.1.2.

10 JUDGE RENDAHL: 9.2.4.3.2?

11 MR. KOPTA: 3.1.2.

12 JUDGE RENDAHL: 3.1.2.

13 MR. KOPTA: It's on page 56 of Exhibit 788.

14 JUDGE RENDAHL: Thank you.

15 MS. LISTON: So basically what we envision  
16 happening is in that first line that says proposed  
17 Colorado trial, we will strike those words. The rest of  
18 it then describes the process that we use for the trial,  
19 so that would remain in place.

20 The last Section 9.2.4.3.1.2.4 has to do with  
21 the bill plan. When we first implemented the Colorado  
22 trial, the bill plan that we had a lengthy discussion  
23 about earlier this morning was not in place, and we have  
24 had that included as part of the trial. Because we have  
25 -- now have an entire section associated with bill plan,

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1 we would recommend that we will strike this paragraph  
2 here, because we have it already addressed in greater  
3 detail someplace else.

4 So what we envision happening as a result of  
5 the agreement to move ahead with a 72 hour FOC would be  
6 striking the words, proposed Colorado, the proposed  
7 Colorado trial, and then striking 9.2.4.3.1.2.4. And  
8 that would become our permanent SGAT language for  
9 rolling out a 72 hour FOC on a going forward basis.

10 JUDGE RENDAHL: Any thoughts?

11 MS. DOBERNECK: I think that is fine by  
12 Covad.

13 JUDGE RENDAHL: Mr. Wilson.

14 MR. WILSON: AT&T was not participating in  
15 the trial. I think we will have to take back to our  
16 operations people if they feel that they should agree  
17 with the 72 hour FOC interval. It is a rather lengthy  
18 interval, and I understand the reasons that Qwest is  
19 using it. I think my concern is after Qwest is in 271,  
20 will they continue to put the special centers and the  
21 special people on these issues so that the intervals and  
22 performance stays good. Of course, that's not something  
23 we can address here. It's something I think of concern  
24 for the long run. But we will take back this issue,  
25 because I don't think we can agree here today for our

1 operations people that the 72 hour FOC is the way that  
2 AT&T would agree to go.

3 JUDGE RENDAHL: Okay, well, then I think it's  
4 an agreement for Covad, but it's an AT&T take back for  
5 the follow-up session.

6 MR. WILSON: Yes.

7 JUDGE RENDAHL: Okay.

8 MS. DOBERNECK: Could we go off the record  
9 for one second.

10 JUDGE RENDAHL: Let's be off the record.

11 (Discussion off the record.)

12 JUDGE RENDAHL: Is there anything further for  
13 issue 5?

14 Okay, let's move on to loop issue 6, which  
15 concerns SGAT Section 9.2.4.2. It's an AT&T issue.

## TRANSCRIPT OF PROCEEDINGS

1  
2 MR. STEESE: This is Chuck Steese for Qwest. We  
3 have a number of people on a transcribed telephone call for  
4 the specific purpose of discussing the Colorado xDSL FOC  
5 trial. A number of people are on from various parties. We  
6 have myself, Jean Liston, Joanne Beck, Greg Eklund are here  
7 on behalf of Qwest. We have Dominic Sekich, Becky DeCook  
8 and Sarah Kilgore on behalf of AT&T. We have Megan  
9 Doberneck and Wayne White on behalf of Covad. We have Tom  
10 Friday on behalf of WorldCom. Do we have anyone else on the  
11 phone?

12 (No audible response.)

13 MR. STEESE: Then with that response being none,  
14 what I thought I would do is remind all of us, myself  
15 included, that this is going to be somewhat difficult for  
16 Melanie to transcribe unless we're all fairly strict about  
17 waiting for other people to finish and not talk over each  
18 other. So probably be a little bit of a stilted call at  
19 times it will appear, but it will make it easier for her.

20 That being said, I just wanted to do a brief  
21 introduction about what Covad and Qwest have done since the  
22 trial, give Miss Liston an opportunity to describe this in  
23 some detail, and give Covad, whether it's through Megan or  
24 Mr. White, an opportunity to describe their point of view,  
25 and then maybe give Miss Liston and Miss Doberneck or

1 Mr. White an opportunity for a short rebuttal, and then have  
2 questions and discussion, if that's acceptable. Does anyone  
3 have a better proposal?

4 MR. DOBERNECK: Chuck, this is Megan Doberneck.  
5 I don't. My only question is I -- is anyone from staff on  
6 this call or is it just the parties?

7 MR. STEESE: It is just the parties. We had  
8 Paul McDaniel from Qwest contact the staff to make sure they  
9 knew of the call, and they told us they knew of the call and  
10 did not plan to have anyone attend.

11 MS. DOBERNECK: Okay. Thank you.

12 MR. STEESE: Sure. Since the last workshop, and  
13 in fact, I'll go back a bit, and this is Chuck Steese for  
14 Qwest, we had a substantial discussion about Qwest's xDSL  
15 FOC trial to discuss whether the trial was a success? Was  
16 it not? What was the outcome of the data?

17 In our rebuttal testimony, Ms. Liston put  
18 forward Qwest's position as to where we stood through, I  
19 believe, the third week of April reminding everyone that the  
20 trial went from March 1 through April 30. And at our last  
21 workshop, Qwest was prepared to put forth its final results  
22 of the trial; however, we had hoped that Covad and we would  
23 be able to meet in advance. That did not occur for reasons  
24 that are already on the record. As a result, we did not  
25 distribute our data as to what we believed the outcome of

1 the results were. Covad presented its initial thoughts.

2 Since that time, Qwest and Covad have exchanged  
3 voice mail messages, telephone calls and information, have  
4 met one time in person to go over various assumptions to  
5 make sure we were all on the same page, and agreements were  
6 reached as to how the remainder of the data exchange would  
7 work. I will give its views, but from Qwest's perspective,  
8 we identified a number of problems that Miss Liston will  
9 describe with the manner in which Covad was calculating its  
10 data. We described those in detail with both Ms. Doberneck  
11 and Mr. White. We reached agreement on what the business  
12 rules assumptions should be for purposes of calculating the  
13 data, and we agreed, this was last Monday, to finalize our  
14 work by Friday of last week.

15 When we looked at the data that we received from  
16 Covad, we got it today rather than last Friday, but be that  
17 as it may, the data on FOC return has improved  
18 significantly. We still think it is substantially  
19 undervaluing how Qwest is performing. But I am hopeful that  
20 even with the fact that we disagree as to the actual number  
21 itself, what percent of FOCs was returned on time, the one  
22 thing I'm hopeful we can agree on is the use of a 72-hour  
23 FOC as an appropriate FOC or interval time for return of an  
24 FOC for xDSL-type loops.

25 I'm also hopeful that Covad would agree with us

1 that we believe the right thing to do is go to the ROC and  
2 ask them to modify PO-5 for these specific types of loops to  
3 move from a 24-hour FOC to 72-hour FOC. The reason for that  
4 is twofold: One, our performance, even by Covad's data, has  
5 improved significantly, if you look at Covad's data.  
6 Certainly, Qwest believes it's more than improved. It's  
7 been extraordinarily good.

8 But in addition to that, if you look today, and  
9 I don't have whole numbers, but round numbers is  
10 approximately 90 percent of these types of loops are already  
11 being provided to carriers who have a 72-hour FOC anyway.  
12 And as a result, PO-5 excludes this data and doesn't track  
13 it. For those of you familiar with the PIDs, the PIDs  
14 exclude longer than normal intervals. And since an FOC of  
15 72 hours is obviously longer than 24 hours, this data is  
16 excluded.

17 And we believe the right thing to do is capture  
18 this data in the Qwest performance metrics that are being  
19 audited and assessed during the course of not only the OSS  
20 test but the performance measures audit, as well. And so  
21 this will be, we think, a step in the right direction,  
22 understanding that Covad and Qwest do disagree as to the  
23 actual calculation of what the FOC return is.

24 And with that, I will hand it to Ms. Liston to  
25 give a detailed overview of Qwest's position.

1 MS. LISTON: Thanks, Chuck. Chuck hit on quite  
2 a few of the high points of the data reconciliation process,  
3 but I'll just take it down just a little further, because I  
4 know that we did see information from Covad at the last  
5 workshop, and the numbers were substantially different than  
6 the numbers that Qwest had filed.

7 Some of the issues that came up that were  
8 different between the Covad data and the Qwest data was that  
9 Covad's data included orders that were not associated with  
10 the trial, specifically, it included some shared loop  
11 issues, the subloop -- I mean, the line-sharing issues.

12 The other thing is that if the orders were  
13 submitted after 7 p.m. on a particular day, the Covad  
14 included them as issued the same day, and that was due to  
15 the way that their internal systems are set up so that they  
16 track from midnight to -- they track until midnight, whereas  
17 the Qwest's rules say that once it hits 7:00, it comes in  
18 after 7 p.m., it's considered next day as the app date. So  
19 we were starting with a different day on many of our  
20 applications dates.

21 The other thing is one of the things that was  
22 interesting in terms of how we started looking at the data  
23 as we peeled back the onion was that in terms of the  
24 decision on whether due date was met or missed were based on  
25 assumptions on Covad's part because they do not track the

1 actual completion date that Qwest turns the unbundled loop  
2 over to them. So again, we were looking at the information  
3 a little bit differently. So those are some of the big  
4 hitters in terms of the differences between our data.

5 The other one that also happened as we talked  
6 through the issues was that orders that needed to be  
7 conditioned were treated as if they had a five-day due date  
8 as opposed to the 15-day due date, and so we needed to  
9 extract those orders. And the other piece was, if the order  
10 was missed due to a customer reason or due to a Covad  
11 reason, the Qwest performance measures excludes those from  
12 commitments met, however, it was included in the Covad  
13 data. So those were the big hitters in terms of orders that  
14 were included in the Covad data that were not included in  
15 the Qwest data.

16 Qwest did provide to Covad a side-by-side  
17 comparison that showed, based on our analysis of the data,  
18 what we saw the results to be, and then where we saw their  
19 numbers coming in based on their analysis, to show where the  
20 differences and discrepancies were, and that was part of how  
21 we started developing the list that I just went through in  
22 terms of differences of approach.

23 There was an e-mail sent out just moments ago  
24 with the final results for the trial, and like Chuck  
25 mentioned, in my testimony, we did not have the end of April

1 results. That has been distributed electronically, and the  
2 Qwest number for the percent FOCs return in 72 hours was  
3 approximately 98 percent, and due dates met were around 98  
4 percent. The overall installation interval for April for  
5 nonconditioned loops was five days, and for conditioned  
6 loops, it came in at 11.6 days. Qwest was very pleased with  
7 the overall results of the trial, and as Chuck mentioned,  
8 would like to see us go ahead and move forward with a  
9 72-hour FOC.

10 We did also, as we sat down with Covad to work  
11 through the numbers, one of the things that we did was we  
12 did share with Covad the information that Qwest has as  
13 backup data so that if we did need to do some detailed  
14 analysis, we could. Qwest did capture every screen print  
15 for every order that occurred during the trial, and we have  
16 not only images of the LSR, but also the raw loop data  
17 information. If we had to open engineering jobs for  
18 conditioning, we have copies of that information, and then  
19 all of the logs associated with the tracking of performance  
20 measures, so we have 14 boxes of backup data available for  
21 any kind of audit trail that we need to do for the trial.

22 That's kind of the overall gist of where we're  
23 at. Like Chuck mentioned, our numbers still are different  
24 than the Covad numbers. We did do an analysis of the Covad  
25 numbers. If we looked strictly at Covad data and did the

1 analysis based on what we saw as the FOC date and the  
2 completion date, we do have numbers. I'm not sure if,  
3 Megan, if you want me to share those, if you view those as  
4 confidential numbers or not, for Covad of the percent met.

5 MR. STEESE: Can I interject for a moment,  
6 Megan?

7 MS. DOBERNECK: Oh, yes, go ahead. Sorry.

8 MR. STEESE: This is Chuck Steese from Qwest.  
9 So long as we don't go into the specific number of loops  
10 you've ordered and we just talk about the percentages, I  
11 would think that that would be generic enough, at least from  
12 Qwest's perspective, that we should be able to do that  
13 without confidentiality, so long as we don't go into  
14 specific numbers of loops you've ordered. Is that  
15 acceptable?

16 MS. DOBERNECK: Two responses. One is I think  
17 talking generically about percentages is not a problem, but  
18 I want to make sure I understand what you're saying, which  
19 is the percentages and the performance you're talking about  
20 is the same data, same percentages, same performance as from  
21 prior to the reconciliation; is that correct?

22 MS. LISTON: Yes, and so it would be if we took  
23 the trial information just the way we did for the whole  
24 state of Colorado and then we looked at the Covad-only  
25 information, and we used some of your data also that, what

1 those numbers come out to.

2 MR. STEESE: And Megan, this is Chuck Steese  
3 again. We provided this data to you approximately ten days  
4 ago when we gave you the first reconciliation where we  
5 identified some of the data issues concerning your  
6 calculations. So it's not going to be any percentage that  
7 you haven't seen before.

8 MS. DOBERNECK: Right. And I understand that.  
9 I just wanted to make sure, before I sort of give my  
10 schpeel, I wanted to make sure that when you're talking  
11 about Qwest's version of its performance, it has not changed  
12 at all through this entire process. We're only focusing on  
13 changes that have come through Covad's data.

14 MS. LISTON: That's correct.

15 MS. DOBERNECK: I just want to make sure we're  
16 all on the same page on that.

17 MS. LISTON: I think so.

18 MS. DOBERNECK: Okay. Well, with that, I don't  
19 know if you're done, Jean. I know you had the question  
20 about if percentages are okay. You know, you are certainly  
21 free to -- I think all of the members of this call, or the  
22 parties to this call are all bound by the nondisclosure  
23 agreement and, you know, I don't have a problem with you  
24 disclosing your analysis of Covad's specific data to the  
25 participants on this call in a percentage format.

1 MS. LISTON: And the reason I wanted to is I  
2 know that to some extent the numbers are very similar to the  
3 state numbers and in some cases they're a little bit lower.  
4 In March -- who just joined?

5 MR. STEESE: I think we had someone drop off,  
6 Jean.

7 MS. LISTON: In March, the percent FOCs returned  
8 in 72 hours based on the Qwest analysis for Covad data only  
9 was 88 percent, and it was 97 percent for April. So it  
10 tracks fairly closely. The March data is a little lower  
11 than the overall state number, but the April number tracks  
12 right with the state number for percent FOCs met.

13 In terms of due dates met, the due date number  
14 for March was 97 percent and for April it was 95 percent.

15 MR. STEESE: Do you have anything more? Because  
16 I have one question I want to ask when you're finished, of  
17 you.

18 MS. LISTON: That's all I had.

19 MR. STEESE: Jean, in looking at this data, you  
20 talked about the 14 boxes of documents that we gathered item  
21 by item as this trial was ongoing. What assumptions, if  
22 any, did Qwest make with respect to the data?

23 MS. LISTON: There were no assumptions made by  
24 Qwest. If, and I'm thinking that you mean by assumptions  
25 where we had to interpret information or anything like that,

1 what we used going into the trial was the FOC, we used the  
2 time stamp from the FOC on when we distributed the FOC to  
3 the CLEC and then our internal completion date was used, and  
4 that would be the same date that would be used for  
5 measurement purposes for any of our performance measures, so  
6 we did not make any assumptions in terms of the data.

7 MR. STEESE: And so if I can ask a couple of  
8 more follow-ups to that. So it would be very possible for  
9 Qwest to make its FOC date and miss its commitment interval;  
10 correct?

11 MS. LISTON: That's correct.

12 MR. STEESE: And it would be just as possible  
13 for us to miss the FOC date but still come back and meet the  
14 actual correct installation interval; correct?

15 MS. LISTON: That's correct. There is one thing  
16 that we did, and we did share this information with Covad,  
17 and I don't think we've shared it with all the parties, that  
18 did occur within the trial, and that was, as we've discussed  
19 in the workshops, we have a 15-day interval for  
20 conditioning.

21 During the trial, the instructions, and we had  
22 to work through this one because it was a different process  
23 than we've done in the past, the instructions to our front  
24 end salespeople were to deliver one meaningful FOC. So to  
25 the extent that an order was in jeopardy situation where we

1 didn't know if we had good facilities, we issued a jeopardy  
2 notice to the CLEC saying it was in a jeopardy status for  
3 facilities, and then we went to look for the existence of  
4 good facilities that matched the request from the CLEC,  
5 whether that be a copper nonloaded loop or whatever.

6           What happened in the trial in some cases is  
7 that -- well, we went ahead and we did something that was  
8 called rapid recovery and also pre-survey where we would be  
9 dispatching technicians into the field to try to recover our  
10 facilities that would work for the end user request.

11           If we were in a situation where we actually  
12 found facilities, in many cases, we contacted the CLEC at  
13 that point in time and said, would you be willing to accept  
14 your circuit early? We have facilities that will work. And  
15 in those cases, we actually turned up the circuits prior to  
16 ever issuing an FOC, because as we were out there, if we  
17 could turn it up, it avoided us having to do a second  
18 dispatch. And in many cases, the CLECs did accept those  
19 circuits early. That did occur during the trial.

20           So in some cases, we provided the loop prior to  
21 the 15 days, at that's why our interval for conditioned  
22 loops is less than 15 days. So we would have considered it  
23 that we met the 15-day interval, but we would have missed  
24 the FOC interval because we never issued an FOC.

25           MR. STEESE: So any time that we issued a

1 jeopardy notice and no FOC, at least with no FOC within the  
2 72 hours, that was counted as a miss?

3 MS. LISTON: That's correct.

4 MR. STEESE: But any time we issued a rejection  
5 notice saying, we have no facilities that meet your demand  
6 per the xDSL FOC guideline, that was counted as a make;  
7 correct?

8 MS. LISTON: If it was done within 72 hours.

9 MR. STEESE: Perfect. That's all that I have.  
10 In addition, Jean, if you have anything else, please add it,  
11 otherwise, why don't we let Covad go, at this point.

12 MS. DOBERNECK: This is Megan Doberneck with  
13 Covad, just give a little sort of recapturing of the history  
14 from our side. When we walked through the reconciliation  
15 process with Qwest, we recognized that there were some loops  
16 that had been included that were line-shared loops that  
17 shouldn't have been. We discussed other areas where we  
18 deviated. For example, Covad operates 24/7, so we worked on  
19 calendar days, but we did modify our data the second time  
20 around to go with just business days to go with the PIDs and  
21 the scope of the xDSL trial.

22 We also eliminated any loops that shouldn't have  
23 been in. Those included line-shared loops, primarily.  
24 There were also some PONs that were included for additional  
25 services ordered for a particular data line say, for

1 example, IP which a PON was generated but wouldn't be  
2 included within the scope of the FOC trial. We also took  
3 that out.

4 With respect to the issue of what day we operate  
5 from, Covad operates from 12:00 to 12:00 whereas Qwest  
6 operates from 7:00 to 7:00. That was something that was  
7 unknown to Covad. Certainly, we believe it sort of deviates  
8 from your typical business practice which goes with a 12:00  
9 to 12:00 interval, but with that being said, we agreed that  
10 we would try and segregate those out. As it turns out, our  
11 automatic date stamp that assigns the FOC receipt date when  
12 we receive it only contains the date rather than the date  
13 and time.

14 In looking at it, it was our belief that  
15 anything, for example, and I think what Jean was pointing  
16 out was orders that came in between 7 p.m. and 12 a.m., that  
17 was the problem area. I don't have the precise numbers  
18 because we can't track that since we don't have a date and  
19 time stamp, we just have a date stamp, but certainly,  
20 knowing the fact that our division that places the orders  
21 operates on East Coast time, and they close shop at 6 p.m.,  
22 even allowing for some delay in orders being received by  
23 Qwest, it's our belief that that is a small number of  
24 orders. Probably more importantly, because we have standard  
25 business rules, we always go from 12:00 to 12:00, Qwest

1 always goes from 7:00 to 7:00, that the regularity of that  
2 cycle would ultimately result in both advantage and  
3 disadvantage to Qwest.

4 For example, if an order came in after 7 p.m.,  
5 the clock would start ticking the next day for Qwest,  
6 because we don't have the ability to control that, we  
7 would -- the clock would start ticking the day before.  
8 Obviously, that situation which our inability to segregate  
9 our 7:00 to 12:00 would disadvantage Qwest.

10 By the same token, for example, if Covad  
11 submitted an order on the first day by 3 p.m., and then  
12 something happened at, say, 7:20 p.m. on the second day, now  
13 that would be three days for Qwest, two days for Covad, but  
14 it would still -- while it would disadvantage Covad from its  
15 perspective of whether it got what it wanted by the time it  
16 believed it should get it, it allowed Qwest to meet the  
17 intervals.

18 So we think it may not be that significant an  
19 issue, either from the regularity, because both companies  
20 operate on the standard clocks, and also just from the flat  
21 out pragmatic perspective that we don't think that many  
22 orders would fall into it.

23 Other issues, as Jean talked about, that we  
24 identified was, for example, PONs that required  
25 conditioning. We did not have the time to get the software

1 engineering done and in place to accommodate that need.  
2 Qwest did provide us with the PONs that required  
3 conditioning, and we did treat them accordingly. There  
4 were, out of a total of X number of orders, since we're  
5 talking generically, only 23 PONs required conditioning.  
6 And what I can represent to you is that is a truly  
7 insignificant number, overall.

8 Another issue: If we could segregate out why a  
9 due date was missed to a customer call. Again, the way our  
10 data, the way we track our data didn't permit us to do that  
11 in the time for this trial. Qwest again provided that to  
12 us, so we segregated out those PONs identified by Qwest.

13 With regard to the interval, this gets us into a  
14 slightly trickier area, and it is the one area in which  
15 Covad did make an assumption with regard to Qwest's  
16 performance. Specifically, when we deem an order closed,  
17 that close date is the date on which Covad can verify that a  
18 good loop has been delivered, in other words, that an end  
19 user customer service, xDSL service is up and running.  
20 Clearly, that combined a couple of the PIDs, it combines  
21 OP-3 which is the installation commitment as well as OP-4  
22 which is new service quality.

23 I agreed with Qwest that we will leave out that  
24 OP-4 issue, and so we agreed to go by the completion date.  
25 But since we couldn't do that, what we assumed instead, and

1 this is the way -- what our data reflects, is that whatever  
2 due date Qwest included in the FOC Covad received, we  
3 assumed 100 percent of the time that Qwest was able to meet  
4 that due date.

5 Now, based on the xDSL trial, that suggests the  
6 due date should be 5 or 15 days depending on whether the  
7 particular loop required conditioning or not. Also, to the  
8 extent that Qwest set a due date that was outside 5 or 15  
9 days and constituted a miss, we believe that that also  
10 constituted a miss. I understand, as Jean said, that for  
11 some of the conditioned loops, they were able to deliver it  
12 before the due date, however, as I mentioned, that's only 23  
13 orders, and it is really a minimal number compared to the  
14 overall volume.

15 Talking specifically about our data, after we  
16 walked through the reconciliation process, what we  
17 determined for PL-5, which is FOCs returned within 72 hours,  
18 for March, our data reflects 74.89 percent of the FOCs were  
19 returned in 72 hours. For April, our data reflects that  
20 76.39 FOCs were returned within 72 hours.

21 If you turn to installation commitments met or  
22 OP-3 for March, and using the assumption that Qwest  
23 delivered the loop 100 percent of the time on the due date  
24 contained in the FOC, Covad's data reflects that in March,  
25 that loop was delivered by the due date 57.88 percent of the

1 time, and for April, that percentage of due dates met  
2 dropped to 44.25 percent.

3 And I don't have anything else to say right now  
4 unless Chuck or Jean has questions or responses or the  
5 parties have questions.

6 MR. STEESE: Before we get to the other parties'  
7 questions, maybe we can at least ask a few questions here.  
8 I'd like to ask one of you and then one of Jean, if I could,  
9 Megan.

10 MS. DOBERNECK: Sure.

11 MR. STEESE: When you say FOCs, did you include  
12 rejects as well as FOCs in that 72 hours?

13 MS. DOBERNECK: Any time Qwest took action,  
14 whether it was reject, cancellation or FOC within the  
15 72-hour period, we counted that as a make. If the action  
16 occurred after 72 hours, whatever it was, you know, no FOC,  
17 rejection after 72 hours or cancellation after 72 hours, we  
18 considered that a miss.

19 MR. STEESE: Okay. Thank you. Then one  
20 question for Jean to clarify something, and then you might  
21 want to react, Megan.

22 MS. DOBERNECK: Sure.

23 MR. STEESE: When Megan assumes that the only  
24 orders affected by the Covad assumption is the 23 orders  
25 that required conditioning, Jean, can you describe whether

1 that would be true, and were there circumstances when we  
2 might miss an FOC, then in our search for facilities,  
3 finding existing facilities, and then identify the due date  
4 as five days and turn it up in that five-day interval and  
5 thereby not count this within the 23 orders that required  
6 conditioning?

7 MS. LISTON: I'd have to go back, Chuck, and  
8 look at the data closely. And here's what I am working  
9 through. And that is, if it was in a situation where we  
10 were looking for assignment and found a loop that worked, it  
11 is possible that we did have some situations that were  
12 jeopardy situations that we would have put on a five-day  
13 interval rather than a 15-day interval time frame, so I  
14 would have to actually go back and look at the data to see  
15 if there were any those of those kind of situations where we  
16 were in a situation where we went in through a jeopardy  
17 process but then delivered in a five-day rather than a  
18 15-day interval.

19 MR. STEESE: I realize I'm not a witness and I  
20 don't know the number, but I thought there were some of  
21 those in this category. And the whole point is, we're not  
22 sure, then, whether this 23 encapsulates all of the  
23 assumptions or not; is that fair?

24 MS. LISTON: That's fair.

25 MS. DOBERNECK: This is Megan Doberneck. And

1 maybe I'm just a little bit thick here, Chuck, and perhaps  
2 you can explain for me, we calculated PO-5 and AP-3  
3 separately. If you made -- if an FOC or a cancel was done  
4 within 72 hours, that was a make or a miss, looking at that  
5 alone. Then taking as a completely separate data point, we  
6 looked as well, okay, we have an FOC with a due date. We  
7 assumed 100 percent of the time that the due date provided  
8 was met by Qwest, and then the question as to whether OP-3  
9 was met or missed was was that within the 5- or 15-day  
10 interval?

11 So I'm not -- I understand what you're trying to  
12 distinguish by, but I'm not certain that we haven't already  
13 done that. And maybe you can explain for my benefit how it  
14 is that you think we haven't done that.

15 MR. STEESE: I think that would be helpful,  
16 because maybe there is something I'm missing here, Megan. I  
17 heard you say, if we returned an FOC --

18 MS. DOBERNECK: Correct.

19 MR. STEESE: -- that you assumed we met the  
20 interval we put forth in the FOC; correct?

21 MS. DOBERNECK: Yes, that you met the due date  
22 contained in the FOC.

23 MR. STEESE: But I'm talking about something  
24 different. I'm talking about a situation where we don't  
25 return an FOC because we're trying to identify facilities,

1 and so we don't return a timely FOC within 72 hours, but at  
2 some point, identify facilities, and then realize the  
3 interval should have been 5 days, and once we identify that  
4 interval as being 5 days, then contact the CLEC and turn the  
5 facility up on time in 5 days, having never returned an  
6 FOC. And it seems to me that that was a possibility, and  
7 knowing what I know about the trial, I am quite confident  
8 that happens; I don't know how often, I'll acknowledge that,  
9 but it seems to me that that would be counted as a miss in  
10 commitments met by your calculations when in reality it  
11 should have been counted as a miss on the FOC but a make on  
12 commitments met.

13 MR. WHITE: Chuck, this is Wayne. How are you?

14 MR. STEESE: Fine, thank you.

15 MR. WHITE: Just curious. I mean, I went  
16 through the data and, I mean, I certainly didn't look for  
17 this specifically, but I'll be more than happy to go through  
18 and look. Mind you, I saw no closed orders when we were  
19 doing the intervals, it didn't have a FOC. I mean, I'm  
20 happy to go and look, but I didn't see any.

21 MS. DOBERNECK: And I guess the question I have  
22 is, how can we possibly track in some ways what is an  
23 informal process in which Qwest calls Covad without sending  
24 the precise document or data that we need to use? I mean, I  
25 think that puts us, for us to respond, that puts us in a

1 very difficult situation, because we have to go by the FOC,  
2 the due date, what have you, so.

3 And again, it may be one order, it may be ten,  
4 it may be hundreds, but I, you know, I would object strongly  
5 to trying to include that in, because that just simply  
6 prevents Covad from trying to stick with, you know, formal  
7 data, you know, with formal data tracking points. It just,  
8 it goes well beyond the formal process and the way it's  
9 supposed to work between the two companies.

10 MR. STEESE: This is Chuck Steese for Covad -- I  
11 mean for Qwest.

12 MS. DOBERNECK: Oh, my God, I can't believe  
13 that.

14 MR. STEESE: When you look at the issue, I'm not  
15 talking about turning up a loop without your knowledge, I'm  
16 talking about the fact that you would do a list and a lay in  
17 consultation, it's just an FOC would not have been issued, a  
18 jeopardy notice would have been issued instead. And a  
19 jeopardy notice does not count as a make. And so we would  
20 have issued the jeopardy, contacted you when we found  
21 existing facilities, and so it would be following the normal  
22 course. And this is what Miss Liston, I thought, described  
23 earlier, and Jean, correct me if I'm wrong, when you said we  
24 made no assumptions. We could miss the FOC and make our  
25 commitment, and vice versa. Is that fair, Jean?

1 MS. LISTON: That's fair, yeah.

2 MS. DOBERNECK: And this is Megan Doberneck with  
3 Covad. And again, I would just object very strongly to  
4 saying that somehow we need to be held accountable or Qwest  
5 gets to take advantage of that. It is not discussed in the  
6 document describing the xDSL FOC trial. It was not  
7 discussed with the exception of conditioned loops during our  
8 meeting. And so I have a real problem with it. And again,  
9 you know, if it's one or two orders, you know, we can like  
10 it or lump it, it's not going to change anything because  
11 that number's so insignificant. But if we're talking about  
12 some process that goes far beyond our ability to track  
13 because we must operate with FOCs, with due dates, I just  
14 don't think that's appropriate.

15 MS. LISTON: And Megan, this is Jean Liston.  
16 Megan, I just did a quick search through April data, and I  
17 can only find two, and this is a real quick search, only two  
18 orders where we did not do an FOC but we did do -- but we  
19 met the due date. And I have not been able to double-check  
20 it yet to see if it also was one that would have had, you  
21 know, been tagged as partially for conditioning, but there  
22 were only two orders that fell into that kind of category  
23 for April. So our numbers are relatively small.

24 MR. STEESE: And here, Megan, and I guess I'm a  
25 little bit perplexed by your strong objection, because it's

1 Qwest's view, or it's been our understanding that the point  
2 was to make sure we gave you a due date you could count on.  
3 And rather than issuing an FOC that Qwest was not sure it  
4 could meet or not because it couldn't tell within that 72  
5 hours, it opted to not issue one, looking at some point to  
6 see if we could turn up service, at what point that could  
7 occur.

8 And so it was always our view that we would work  
9 in process, understanding that it would not be possible for  
10 us 100 percent of the time to conclude whether there were or  
11 were not facilities to support your requested service within  
12 the 72 hours. And so that's not our attempt to fall out of  
13 process at all, it's our attempt to make sure that we give  
14 you a meaningful FOC.

15 MS. LISTON: And Chuck, to the extent that we  
16 did not issue that FOC in 72 hours, we did take it as a miss  
17 on the FOC.

18 MR. STEESE: Correct.

19 MS. DOBERNECK: And this is Megan Doberneck.  
20 Just to respond, and then I think we can probably move on,  
21 because I think the numbers will be insubstantial, but it  
22 won't affect things one way or another, but I think your  
23 very first sentence, Chuck, raises the point. You said, we  
24 need a due date.

25 We never got a due date. And it's not only that

1 we care about getting good loops on time, but the whole  
2 concept of the meaningful FOC is so we can work with our  
3 partners, work with our end users, and have certainty when  
4 we give them a date. So that's why we focused on the due  
5 date and why we love getting loops. That doesn't alleviate  
6 the problem of, how do we manage our customers when we're  
7 not provided with a due date or a due date that we can rely  
8 on? So, you know, I'll leave it at that, because I think it  
9 won't matter overall for the purposes of this trial, and I'm  
10 happy to move on, or if you want to respond, that's fine,  
11 also.

12 MR. STEESE: I think we can move on to the next  
13 issue. The only other thing that I wanted to make mention  
14 of that Megan talked about before was the 7 p.m. cut-off  
15 versus the midnight-midnight discussion. Qwest sees this as  
16 always operating to its disadvantage. There's a five-hour  
17 period when Covad can submit orders, when anything received  
18 in that date, Covad thinks we should return something one  
19 day sooner.

20 And so, she said that this operates at times to  
21 our disadvantage and sometimes to our advantage. When you  
22 work from a 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. cut-off, no matter when you  
23 issue it between 7:00 and 7:00 the next morning, it starts  
24 the next morning. And so we see this as always working to  
25 our disadvantage.

1 MS. DOBERNECK: Chuck, are you done?

2 MR. STEESE: Yes, I am.

3 MS. DOBERNECK: Jean, this is Megan Doberneck.  
4 Do you know the number of orders that fall within that time  
5 period?

6 MS. LISTON: I know, Megan, that we had  
7 identified the orders where we had a disagreement on the FOC  
8 date -- I mean, on the application date. I have not done a  
9 count on that in terms of the numbers that fall into that  
10 category, but I know that our backup documentation that we  
11 provided to you did show those, where our application dates  
12 were different, and in most cases, they were a day  
13 different, and we did not go back and look to see if those  
14 would have been what fell into the after 7:00. And I have  
15 not done a count on that.

16 MS. DOBERNECK: Okay. Thank you.

17 MR. STEESE: Do you have a rough number, Jean?  
18 Or I mean, is it --

19 MS. LISTON: I really have not looked at what  
20 the total was on that, Chuck.

21 MR. STEESE: Okay. That's fair enough. And in  
22 regards to those orders, whether it's -- no matter what the  
23 number is, that would impact not only the FOC issuance but  
24 also the commitments met interval, as well; correct?

25 MS. LISTON: Yes, it would.

1 MS. DOBERNECK: It would not impact it from the  
2 way Covad calculated the data, however, for the installation  
3 commitments met, but yes, you're correct, it would  
4 conceivably impact whether the FOC was returned within 72  
5 hours, so it has impact on PO-5 but not OP-3.

6 MR. STEESE: I don't understand that. Let's  
7 assume that you believe you issued an order today and it's  
8 received after 7 p.m. The five-day interval begins to run  
9 from tomorrow, and you would calculate it from today. So  
10 how is that not impacting commitments met, Megan? I don't  
11 get that.

12 MS. DOBERNECK: Well, two reasons. The one is  
13 because we operated on the 100 percent assumption that you  
14 delivered the loop on the due date included in the FOC,  
15 that's one way. The second way is because you have, for  
16 example, an -- hold on. Let me have Wayne explain this part  
17 of it.

18 MR. WHITE: Hi, Chuck. This is Wayne White from  
19 Covad. Really, what it comes down to, as long as it's used  
20 consistently by both companies, the metrics does officially  
21 a wash. The way it works is this: In fact, you're correct,  
22 if you give us something past 7:00 or we gave you something  
23 past 7:00, the clock may start working as the very next day,  
24 but there's that same time differential on the other side.  
25 If we wind up closing the order out, let's say, after 7:00,

1 and you would show it as another day past that, we're not  
2 going to. It would show the day earlier. So, I mean, what  
3 really is concerned here is that you use the rules  
4 consistently. We go 12:00 to 12:00 to 12:00 to 12:00 to  
5 12:00, you go 7:00 to 7:00 to 7:00 to 7:00 to 7:00 to 7:00,  
6 you wind up with the same universe, just offset by a few  
7 hours.

8 MR. STEESE: Does anyone else on the call have  
9 questions? I don't have anything more. Jean, do you have  
10 anything more?

11 MS. LISTON: There was just one other thing that  
12 I wanted to raise, and we have not had a chance to look at  
13 the detailed Covad data to try to make heads or tails out of  
14 this, and that is in terms of the OP-3 measures, commitments  
15 met, and Wayne and I did get a chance briefly to talk about  
16 this, the number of orders that are included for the OP-3  
17 measures are less than the number of orders on the PO-5  
18 measure. And Wayne and I, as we talked it through, he said,  
19 well, those are not showing closed in the Covad system. And  
20 in the Covad system, of course, it has to do when they  
21 actually close their orders out or turn the loops up to  
22 their end user customer.

23 There may also be -- that also may reflect why  
24 there are some differences between our data and theirs in  
25 terms of the OP-3 measure, and that is that there's a

1 significant chunk of orders that have not been included in  
2 the trial data for the OP-3. But we have not had a chance  
3 to look at the Covad data yet.

4 MR. STEESE: Megan, at this point, I'd recommend  
5 opening it up to the floor for questions. Do you have  
6 anything more you'd like to add?

7 MS. DOBERNECK: No, I think we've covered all  
8 the ground that we need to cover absent specific questions.

9 MR. STEESE: Then we'll open it up for  
10 questions, and if someone has questions, please introduce  
11 yourself by name for Melanie's benefit.

12 (No audible response.)

13 MR. STEESE: I'm assuming, then, that we have no  
14 questions?

15 MS. DeCOOK: Hey, Chuck, it's Becky DeCook. I  
16 don't have any questions, and I doubt most of us do, because  
17 it's really hard to get a sense of the discussion without  
18 looking at information, but I did have a question about  
19 process, and that is, what are your next steps and what's  
20 Covad's next step given where it sounds like you're at?

21 MR. STEESE: If I can answer that, Megan, and if  
22 you want to disagree or agree, please do, we were talking  
23 about that, since we exchanged the data today, Megan and I  
24 did not get as much time as I know I would have liked, I  
25 assume she would have liked, to talk that very question

1 through.

2 At this point in our trial, we said that our  
3 recommendations would be to go to the ROC and ask them to  
4 modify PO-5 as it relates to these specific performance  
5 metrics, also to Arizona for the same reason. And given  
6 that what I said at the beginning of this call is that a  
7 tremendous percentage, about 90 percent of these types of  
8 loops are already being provided to carriers that have a  
9 72-hour FOC and are therefore being excluded from the data,  
10 my strong recommendation would be to go to the ROC and to  
11 Arizona and get the metrics modified such that we can start  
12 tracking this data through some audited metrics that will  
13 allow all parties to see how we're performing on a monthly  
14 basis. And so that would be my recommendation. And I  
15 think, I'm being presumptuous maybe, that Megan would agree  
16 with that.

17 MS. DOBERNECK: And this is Megan Doberneck.  
18 And we are one of the carriers operating under a 72-hour  
19 agreement currently, so we have no objection from the PIDs  
20 standpoint of going to 72 hours, because I think, you know,  
21 our eyes are on the prize. We want whatever will give Qwest  
22 the opportunity to deliver loops in a timely fashion, so I  
23 don't have a problem agreeing to 72 hours.

24 MR. STEESE: This is Chuck Steese with Qwest.  
25 Did that answer your question, Becky?

1 MS. DeCOOK: Well, I guess my question is, is  
2 she now closed for purposes of the workshop or -- and  
3 performance issues are going to be deferred to the ROC test,  
4 essentially?

5 MR. STEESE: Certainly, performance -- I mean,  
6 the performance question is one that we have disagreement  
7 over, obviously. And Qwest and Covad, I think, at least  
8 from our perspective, we'd like to continue to work with  
9 Covad to see if we can't look at some of their underlying  
10 documents to see if we can continue to work out some of  
11 these data issues.

12 I understand that Covad has some resource issues  
13 in terms of putting more resource to this issue, and Qwest  
14 at least would like to informally work with Covad to look  
15 through their data to see if we can't further limit or  
16 explain or understand better where we diverge.

17 But in terms of the workshop issue, I would  
18 think, and I know I'm speaking for only myself at this  
19 point, that this issue would be closed, understanding that  
20 as we get data from these PIDs on a monthly basis, and no, I  
21 don't know how long it would take to change, et cetera, the  
22 PIDs, that it will give us a better idea of how we are  
23 performing. And I open that up to Megan for your views.

24 MS. DOBERNECK: From the perspective of what  
25 further work can we do, certainly, as I've discussed with

1 Chuck, and you all have probably heard before in the  
2 workshops, we are certainly virtually at exhaust on the time  
3 and resources we can allocate to this further. That being  
4 said, we are certainly going to try and accommodate Qwest's  
5 requests to do further reconciliation, although, I really  
6 see the only issue as being the orders that fall between  
7 the -- in that 7:00 to 12:00 time window. Other than that,  
8 you know, we stand by our data. We stand by what our  
9 internal data reflects as to when we get a FOC from Qwest.  
10 So that's one part of my answer.

11 The second part of my answer is the fact that it  
12 was my understanding that we would be briefing this issue in  
13 connection with the 271 workshops, but the idea was we would  
14 be pushing it out after the due date for the remainder of  
15 the impasse issues for loops and line-splitting and NIDs to  
16 see how much reconciliation there could be and how discrete  
17 it could be. So it would not be my understanding that we  
18 disperse the ultimate issue to the ROC but that we do some  
19 briefing within the context of this loop's workshop on the  
20 FOC trial.

21 MR. STEESE: And Megan, maybe you and I need to  
22 work off line to figure out what that issue or issues should  
23 be. I'm struggling. I mean, the issue that I would tend to  
24 think you would brief is, should this be a 72-hour FOC or a  
25 24-hour FOC? And so if we're agreeing that 72 hours is the

1 appropriate time, I would just need to better understand  
2 what it is that we're actually briefing.

3 MS. DOBERNECK: And I'll tell you, that was a  
4 big reason why I was hoping somebody from staff would be on  
5 the call because it is such a significant issue. I don't  
6 want to say it's limited just to 72 hours. I think there  
7 are some principal bases underlying fair and meaningful  
8 competition that the Commission needs to be cognizant of and  
9 that, you know, whether we see these are our positions, that  
10 is why it matters, do with it what you will or resolve it  
11 per OSS testing, I don't feel comfortable just leaving it at  
12 72 versus 24, but, you know, making Covad's position known  
13 that this is, you know, this breaks our back in trying to  
14 compete for xDSL customers.

15 MR. STEESE: And if that's where we end up, that  
16 would be fine. Megan, why don't you and I touch base off  
17 line just sometime this week. I know then we're going to  
18 want to try and get the underlying documentation so we can  
19 better understand where we are, get a look at your  
20 underlying material, see if we can't better understand how  
21 you got to this data, and certainly, then, find a way that  
22 we can brief this understanding that all parties will need  
23 an opportunity that extends this out away from the normal  
24 loop brief, and we'll work on that separately and this will  
25 be briefed as a separate issue.

1 MS. DOBERNECK: And I think that that sounds  
2 fine. And just so participants to this call now, I will  
3 send out to those who have signed nondisclosure agreements,  
4 our revised or reconciled, however you want to call it, data  
5 just so they can, I know that we all received Qwest's just a  
6 bit ago, and they can do another side-by-side comparison  
7 with how our numbers have changed.

8 MR. STEESE: Okay. Does anyone else have any  
9 more questions?

10 (No audible response. )

11 MR. STEESE: With that, Melanie, can you get  
12 Megan and myself a copy of the transcript? And we will make  
13 sure that we file a copy of this transcript, or that Qwest  
14 does, with the Colorado Commission and electronically  
15 distributes it to the other parties. We can go off the  
16 record at this point.

17 (The conference call was concluded at 4:06 p.m.,


