MOTION FOR REVISED
PROCEDURAL ORDER

Mohave Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Mohave") files this Motion for Revised
Procedural Order in the above-captioned matters. The purpose of the Motion is to allow the
parties time to pursue resolution of this matter. This Motion is made following a May 31,
2005 telephonic procedural conference with Judge Nodes, UNS Electric, Inc. ("UNS"),
Commission Staff ("Staff") and Mohave. During the conference UNS, Staff and Mohave all
expressed support for suspending all existing procedural dates excepting the hearing date.
After consultation with Staff and UNS, Mohave proposes the following revised procedural
schedule:

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<u>Date due</u>	<u>Action to be Completed</u>
June 15, 2005	Mohave and UNS to file any proposed resolution
June 17, 2005	Telephonic Status Conference at 9:00 a.m.
June 24, 2005	Direct testimony and exhibits for hearing on behalf of Mohave, UNS and Intervenors to be filed
July 22, 2005	Supplemental Staff Report and associated exhibits of Staff to be filed
July 29, 2005	Rebuttal testimony and exhibits of Mohave, UNS and Intervenors to be filed, if necessary
Aug. 1, 2005	Any objections to testimony or exhibits to be filed
Aug. 2, 2005	Hearing

Mohave and UNS, as between themselves, have also agreed (1) to suspend further discovery; (2) that any information provided to Staff after March 31, 2005 by Mohave or UNS designated as privileged or confidential by the submitting party shall not constitute a waiver of the claim of privilege or confidentiality towards UNS or Mohave; and (3) that such information provided by Mohave or UNS to Staff shall not be sought from Staff by Mohave or UNS except pursuant to written confidentiality agreement between Mohave and UNS or pursuant to an order of the Administrative Law Judge.

Mohave, with the support of the other parties, respectfully submits that revising


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the procedural schedule, as set forth herein, will further the public interest.
