THIRD  
PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On February 17, 2005, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Temporary Order to Cease and Desist ("T.O.") and a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against MGN Enterprises, Inc. ("MGN"), John S. Mendibles (collectively the "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of investment contracts.

Respondents were duly served with a copy of the T.O. and the Notice.

On April 4, 2005, Respondents filed an Answer and request for a hearing.

On April 6, 2005, by Procedural Order, a pre-hearing conference was scheduled for May 10, 2005.

On May 10, 2005, at the pre-hearing conference, the Division appeared through counsel. Respondents did not appear and the Division indicated that a hearing should be scheduled. By Procedural Order, a hearing was scheduled for June 21 and 22, 2005. The parties were further ordered to exchange copies of exhibits and witness lists by June 7, 2005.

On June 8, 2005, the Division filed a Motion to Continue ("Motion") the proceeding because

1 Respondent, John S. Mendibles, is in the custody of the Maricopa County Sheriff at the detention  
2 facility on Lower Buckeye Road in Phoenix, Arizona pending posting of bond and/or trial in a  
3 criminal proceeding in Maricopa County Superior Court.

4 Accordingly, the Division's Motion should be granted and the hearing should be continued  
5 indefinitely.

6 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion of the Securities Division is hereby granted  
7 and the hearing shall be continued indefinitely.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all dates for the exchange of exhibits and witness lists are  
9 hereby vacated.


