I oppose the \$8.50/month (28.3%) increase to my wastewater utility fee as a result of Johnson Utilities Company taking over the assets and service of Arizona Utility Supply & Services customers. Johnson Utilities Company acquired an expanded customer base and existing infrastructure from this transfer. The company does not have the costs of constructing/installing new systems to service these new customers and in fact should recognize substantial savings through economies of scale. It should not require an additional \$100 per year per household.

I realize that companies wish to realize generous profits. However, in the case of monopolies where customers have no choice in who will provide services, these profits should not be allowed to escalate just because homeowners have no choice but to pay for the service.
