Dear Corporation Commission Staff,

Adelphia hereby encloses responses to the Corporation Commission Staff's First Set of Data Requests to Adelphia Telecommunications, Inc. ("Adelphia"). Adelphia would also like to inform the Arizona Corporation Commission that Adelphia has received a potential offer to purchase its long distance services and customer base. Adelphia therefore requests the Corporation Commission to stay or suspend Adelphia's application to discontinue long distance services in the State of Arizona until Adelphia is able to determine whether the sale will proceed. The potential offer for Adelphia's long distance services was made after Adelphia filed the application on May 11, 2005 to the Corporation Commission to discontinue telecommunications services. If the sale proceeds and is approved by the bankruptcy court, Adelphia may request to cancel its application to discontinue telecommunication services, and instead transfer its customer base to another long distance provider. In the event of such a transfer, Adelphia shall provide further public notice of this transfer in each Arizona county, if that is the Corporation Commission's preference.

If the Corporation Commission would like Adelphia to take any further action at this time in relation to the potential sale of its long distance services and customer base, please let me know. Adelphia has not yet sent letters to its Arizona customers informing them of the discontinuation of Adelphia's long distance services. In the event that Adelphia proceeds with discontinuation of long distance services in Arizona, Adelphia will give its customers a minimum of 30 days' notice by letter.

Please do not hesitate to contact me if I can provide any further information on this matter.
