PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On March 10, 2005, Chaparral City Water Company ("Chaparral City" or "Company") filed with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for an order preliminary to the extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N"), pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282.D, the terms of which would allow Chaparral City to extend its CC&N to include approximately 1,300 acres of State Trust land located north of the Town of Fountain Hills and immediately adjacent to Chaparral City's existing CC&N area.

On April 4, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") and Chaparral City filed a Joint Request for Procedural Schedule setting forth a proposed schedule for the conduct of this proceeding.

By Procedural Order issued April 13, 2005, a hearing was scheduled for August 16, 2005, and other procedural timelines were established, including a July 1, 2005 deadline for filing of a Staff Report.

On May 12, 2005, the Company filed a Certificate of Publication and Proof of Mailing.

On June 28, 2005, Staff filed a request for extension of time to file its Staff Report, until July 8, 2005, and a request that Chaparral City be given an equivalent extension of its deadline for filing a response to the Staff Report. Staff represented that the Company has agreed to the proposed extension request.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Staff's request for an extension of time to file its Staff Report shall be granted. The Staff Report shall therefore be filed on or before July 8, 2005.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Chaparral City shall reduce to writing and file any rebuttal
2 testimony and associated exhibits to be presented at the hearing and/or objections to the Staff Report
3 on or before August 5, 2005.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in all other respects the April 13, 2005 Procedural Order
5 shall remain in full force and effect.

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the ex parte rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 – Unauthorized
7 Communications) continues to apply to this proceeding as the matter has been set for hearing.

8 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter, amend,
9 or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at
10 hearing.
