Please accept the original and thirteen (13) copies of this correspondence to provide additional compliance information as required in Decision 67949, on behalf of BullsEye Telecom, Inc.

Decision No. 67949 in Docket No. T-04276A-05-0084 Order states that the application of BullsEye Telecom, Inc. for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity for authority to provide competitive resold local exchange services is hereby granted, conditioned upon its compliance with the conditions recommended by Staff as set forth in Findings of Fact Nos. 10, 11 and 12, as included in the Decision. The company respectfully reports on its compliance with those Findings of Fact.

Findings of Fact No. 10

(a) That BullsEye procure an interconnection agreement before being allowed to offer service and that this agreement should be procured within 365 days of the effective date of the Order in this matter or 30 days prior to the provision of service, whichever comes first.

BullsEye has procured an interconnection agreement with Qwest. This agreement covers both facilities-based and resale provisioning of local exchange services and has been filed with the Commission and docketed as of April 12, 2005 under the following docket numbers:

BullsEye: T-04276A-05-0263  
Qwest: T-01051B-05-0263

(b) That BullsEye file a plan to have its customers telephone numbers included in the incumbent's Directories and Directory Assistance databases within 365 days of the effective date of the Order or 30 days prior to the provision of service, whichever comes first.

BullsEye certifies that its customers telephone numbers will be included in the incumbent's Directories and Directory Assistance databases per its Interconnection Agreement with Qwest.

(g) That BullsEye certify through the 911 service provider in the area in which it intends to provide service, that all issues associated with the provision of 911 service have been resolved with emergency service providers before it begins to provide local exchange service. This certification should be filed with the Commission within 365 days of an Order or 30 days prior to the provision of service, whichever comes first.

BullsEye certifies that all 911 issues are resolved, and that information regarding requirements for 911/E911 are contained in the company's Interconnection Agreement with Qwest.

Findings of Fact No. 11

That BullsEye file conforming tariffs for each Certificate in accordance with the Decision.

Through this Docket and Decision, BullsEye obtains authority to provide local exchange service on a resale basis.

BullsEye had previously obtained authority to provide local exchange service on a facilities-basis (Docket No. 04273A-04-0667, Decision No. 67751).

The method of providing service is transparent to end user customers and therefore the company has only one local exchange tariff on file with the Arizona Corporation Commission. The tariff submitted with the company's application for local resale in this docket was the same as that filed for facilities-based services. This matter has been reviewed with Adam LeBrecht of Staff and Staff has supported the company's position that a single tariff for all local exchange services - facilities-based and resale - is adequate.

The company's local exchange services tariff (originally for facilities-based services and now including resale services) was filed on April 15, 2005 in Docket No. 04273A-04-0667, Decision No. 67751.

Findings of Fact No. 12

That BullsEye procure a bond equal to \$25,000 and docket such performance bond.

BullsEye filed a bond equal to \$135,000 on March 30, 2005 under the docket number for the company's facilities-based local authority (Docket No. 04273A-04-0667, Decision No. 67751).

The company anticipated the \$25,000 requirement for local resale when it filed its bond.

This bond amount consists of \$100,000 for facilities-based local authority, \$10,000 for toll authority and \$25,000 for resold local authority for a total amount of \$135,000. The company has received a date-stamped confirmation from the Arizona Corporation Commission Document Control indicating receipt of said bond.

Two separate bonds would require cancelling the existing bond, replacing it with two separate bonds and paying for two bonds instead of one. Given that the company is offering all local exchange services (facilities-based and resale) from a single tariff, and that the cost of managing two bonds is greater than holding the existing single bond, the company respectfully requests that the existing bond be acknowledged to cover all of the authorities granted to the company.
