Dear Honorable Jane L. Rodda:

We are writing to you in reference to a meeting that was held in Tucson concerning a sewage system for the town site of San Manuel on June 29, 2005 which the homeowners and renters were supposed to be notified and being new residents of only a few months, we knew nothing of the meeting until after it was held.

It is an extreme concern that these Dockets will put a burden on our community that will be too difficult for most people who live here to handle.

I am a pastor and we have many families who because of the closure of the mine here have been put in situations where they are on a very fixed income living from paycheck to paycheck and struggle because of the difficulty of finding jobs to support their families because of having to drive a considerable distance for employment purposes. There are also many who are retired.

We would appreciate it if you would consider more investigation into BHP's purchase commitment to provide San Manuel with an adequate sewer facility. It seems to us that they are wanting the community to pay for the upgrade that they were responsible to provide and have not done so.

I am asking that we be provided a facility that could be licensed when sold as BHP will be the one profiting from the sale not the community itself.

I am also asking for sewage services that will be provided for \$12 to \$18 per month which is the Fair Market Value for our area.
