INSUFFICIENCY LETTER

Dear Mr. Grapp:

This letter is to inform you that the application of Mark Grapp dba Serviceberry Water Co. for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (“CC&N”), Docket No. W-02481A-05-0446, has not met the sufficiency requirements as outlined in the Arizona Administrative Code. To be deemed sufficient, the following information should be sent to Staff:

1. Please provide a written request for deletion from each of the property owners who are requesting deletion.
2. How many customers are currently being served in the area proposed to be deleted?
3. If there are customers currently being served in the area proposed to be deleted, when will they receive service from another water service provider?

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-411(C)(3), Staff may request administrative closure of an application if the applicant does not remedy all deficiencies listed above within 60 calendar days of this notice of insufficiency. Once sufficiency is met, the Commission has 150 calendar days for its substantive review. This time period will encompass the filing of a Staff Report, a hearing, a Recommended Opinion and Order and a Decision from the Commission.
