PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 21, 2001, Arizona Corporation Commission Staff ("Staff") filed a Motion to Schedule New Workshop Dates.

Staff seeks approval to schedule a workshop on December 12 -14, 2001, to consider performance data issues and Qwest Corporation's Stand-Alone Test Environment ("SATE"). Under Staff's proposal, parties would be required to file questions and comments on the reports on or before December 7, 2001.

Staff also requested that the Commission set a workshop for December 17 and 18, 2001, to review Qwest's Change Management Process. Qwest has indicated that it will issue a final report on its Change Management Process on November 30, 2001.

Staff reports that the most active participants in the workshop process have agreed to Staff's proposed dates. No party has filed an objection or otherwise commented on Staff's Motion. Staff states that parties will be allowed to submit additional comments and questions, if any, before the final workshop in January.

Because the reports on the SATE and Change Management Process could not be issued until November 30, 2001, additional workshops to address these matters are required. Based on the fact that no party objects to the proposed dates, and allowing additional questions and comments on these issues before the final workshop in January 2002, Staff's proposed schedule is reasonable and should be adopted.

1 On December 5, 2001, AT&T filed a Second Notice Of Scheduling Issues that indicates in
2 AT&T's opinion, circumstances may prevent a complete Final Report being issued on December 21,
3 2001, as currently scheduled. The issues AT&T raises in its Second Notice are important and may
4 affect the schedule for issuing a Final Report and subsequent dates for the Workshop on the Final
5 Report and the issuance of a final Final Report, however, these issues do not affect the need for the
6 additional Workshops on Qwest's performance data, SATE and Change Management Process. We
7 will address additional potential changes to the Workshop and Report schedule at a later date.

8 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the workshop schedule in the above-captioned matter
9 shall be modified to include the following workshops:
