**BY THE COMMISSION:**

12 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the  
13 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

14  
15 1. On December 9, 1998, dPi-Teleconnect, LLC ("Applicant") filed with the  
16 Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide  
17 competitive resold local exchange and interexchange telecommunications services within the State of  
18 Arizona.

19  
20 2. In Decision No. 58926 (December 22, 1994), the Commission found that resold  
21 telecommunications providers ("resellers") were public service corporations subject to the  
22 jurisdiction of the Commission.

23  
24 3. In Decision No. 59124 (June 23, 1995), the Commission adopted A.A.C. R14-2-1101  
through R14-2-1115 to regulate resellers.

25  
26 4. Applicant is a Texas limited liability company authorized to do business in Arizona  
since 1999.

27  
28 5. On June 22, 1999, Applicant filed affidavits of publication indicating it had published  
notice of its application for authority to provide resold interexchange services.
