PROCEDURAL ORDER

**BY THE COMMISSION:**

On December 9, 1998, dPi-Teleconnect, L.L.C. ("Applicant") filed with Docket Control of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide interLATA/intraLATA telecommunications services as a reseller within the State of Arizona. Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1104 and R14-2-1105, Applicant filed affidavits of publication related to the provision of interexchange service. The record does not reflect that Applicant published notice of its intent to provide local exchange service. On September 25, 1999, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed its Staff Report in this matter, recommending denial of the application without a hearing because Applicant has not responded to Staff's request for information.

Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested by any party.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-1106 and R14-2-1108, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Applicant shall file written exceptions, if any, to the Staff Report or request that a hearing be set by December 18, 2000.


IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant's failure to respond to the Staff Report and Staff's requests to information or to request a hearing may result in the denial of this Application.


