PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On November 19, 2004, The Water Utility of Greater Tonopah ("Company" or "Applicant"), filed an application for an extension of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") with the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") to provide public water utility service to various parts of Maricopa County, Arizona.

On December 7, 2004, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-411, the Commission's Utilities Division ("Staff") issued a notice of insufficiency.

On June 20, 2005, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-2-411, Staff issued a letter of sufficiency.

In accordance with A.R.S. § 41-1074(A), the application was deemed administratively complete.

On June 21, 2005, pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission issued a Procedural Order which scheduled a hearing on August 25, 2005.

On August 25, 2005, a full public hearing was convened before a duly authorized Administrative Law Judge of the Commission at its offices in Phoenix, Arizona. The Company and Staff appeared with counsel. Public comment was taken at the outset and a brief recess taken after which the parties agreed to a short continuance to resolve certain issues prior to the evidentiary portion of the proceeding.

Accordingly, the proceeding should be continued for a short period and the time-frame


1 suspended.

2 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** shall be continued to **October 6, 2005, at**
3 **9:30 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at the Commission's offices, 1200 West Washington
4 Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the time-frame shall be suspended until further Order

6 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the presiding Administrative Law Judge may rescind, alter,
7 amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by
8 ruling at hearing.


