FOURTH
PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 27, 2005, the Securities Division ("Division") of the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") filed a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing ("Notice") against Christopher D. Dedmon and Kimberly Dedmon and Omni Horizon Group, LLC ("Omni") (collectively "Respondents") in which the Division alleged multiple violations of the Arizona Securities Act ("Act") in connection with the offer and sale of securities in the form of evidences of indebtedness for shares of stock.

Respondents were duly served with a copy of the Notice.

On May 11, 2005, Respondents filed a request for a hearing. By Procedural Order, a pre-hearing was scheduled for June 7, 2005. Although the Procedural Order indicated that Respondents had filed an Answer, Respondents filed only a request for hearing and should file their Answer within 30 calendar days of the date of receipt of the Notice.

On May 18, 2005, by Procedural Order, Respondents were ordered to file an Answer.

On May 26, 2005, Respondents filed their Answer.

On June 6, 2005, Respondents telephonically requested a brief continuance because they are out of state. By Procedural Order, the pre-hearing was continued from June 7, 2005 to June 23, 2005.

1 On June 23, 2005, the Division appeared through counsel and Respondents appeared on their
2 own behalf. The parties indicated that they are attempting to conclude a Consent Order for approval
3 by the Commission. In the interim, the Division requested that a hearing be scheduled.

4 On June 24, 2005, by Procedural Order, the hearing was scheduled to commence on
5 September 13, 2005.


6 On August 25, 2005, the Division filed what was captioned "Stipulated Request to Continue
7 Hearing" ("Request") pending submission of a proposed Consent Order to the Commission for its
8 approval at Open Meeting on September 22, 2005.

9 Accordingly, the Request is reasonable and the hearing should be continued.

10 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** to be held on September 13, 2005 shall be
11 **continued indefinitely.**

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Division shall request the hearing be rescheduled, if
13 necessary.


