PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

On April 5, 2004, CommPartners, LLC ("Applicant" or "CommPartners") submitted to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide facilities-based interexchange and local exchange telecommunications services within the State of Arizona. The application petitioned the Commission for determination that its proposed services should be classified as competitive.

On June 14, 2005, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff Report recommending approval of CommPartners's application subject to certain conditions.

On June 22, 2005, by Procedural Order, the matter was set for hearing to commence on August 11, 2005. The Procedural Order also set forth associated deadlines which ordered Applicant to publish notice of the hearing by July 11, 2005 and docket its Affidavit of Publication on or before July 29, 2005.

On August 11, 2005, a full public hearing was conducted before a duly authorized Administrative Law Judge. Applicant appeared telephonically and the Legal Division appeared on behalf of Staff. At the commencement of the hearing, it was noted that the record did not reflect that notice of the hearing had been published pursuant to the Procedural Order. Accordingly, the matter was continued and the matter is being reset for hearing.

Pursuant to A.A.C. R14-3-101, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

1 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the **hearing** on the above application and petition of
2 Applicant shall commence on **October 4, 2005 at 10:00 a.m.**, or as soon thereafter as is practical, at
3 the Commission’s offices, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007.

4 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Applicant shall publish notice of its filing and the hearing,
5 as stated below, in a newspaper(s) of general circulation in every county in Arizona in which
6 Applicant desires to provide service by September 9, 2005, and shall file Affidavits of Publication
7 with the Commission no later than September 23, 2005.

15 CommPartners, LLC (“Applicant”) has filed with the Arizona Corporation
16 Commission (“Commission”) an application for a Certificate of Convenience and
17 Necessity (“Certificate”) to provide competitive facilities-based interexchange and
18 local exchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be
19 required by the Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and
20 terms and conditions established by the Commission.

21 The application, report of the Commission’s Utilities Division Staff, and any
22 written exceptions to the staff report prepared by the applicant are available for
23 inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at
24 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at Applicant, [address].

25 Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the
26 proceedings and participate as a party. You may have the right to intervene in the
27 proceeding, or you may make a statement for the record. Intervention shall be in
28 accordance with A.A.C. R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed
on or before **September 23, 2005**. Persons desiring to intervene must file a written
motion to intervene with the Commission and send such motion to the Company or its
counsel and to all parties of record, and which at the minimum, shall contain the
following:

1. The name, address, and telephone number of the proposed intervenor and of
any party upon whom service of documents is to be made if different than the
intervenor.
2. A short statement of the proposed intervenor’s interest in the proceeding
(e.g. a customer of the company, a shareholder of the company, a competitor, etc.).
3. A statement certifying that a copy of the motion to intervene has been
mailed to the Company or its counsel and to all parties of record in the case.

A.A.C. R14-3-105 shall govern the granting of motions to intervene. The
granting of intervention, among other things, entitles a party to present sworn evidence

at the hearing and to cross-examine other witnesses. However, failure to intervene will not preclude any interested person or entity from appearing at the hearing and making a statement on their own behalf. The hearing is scheduled to commence on **October 4, 2005 at 10:00 a.m.** at the Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007. Please check with the Commission for any changes to the scheduled hearing date.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Presiding Officer may rescind, alter, amend, or waive any portion of this Procedural Order either by subsequent Procedural Order or by ruling at hearing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Ex Parte Rule (A.A.C. R14-3-113 - Unauthorized Communications) applies to this proceeding as the matter is now set for public hearing.


