Dear Commissioners Gleason and Mayes;

Your concern for the homeowners and ratepayers in Pinal County is appreciated and exactly what voters expect from their elected Commissioners.

As a long time resident of Pinal County, I welcome your study of our needs.

Commissioner Mayes notes that some 70 fewer homeowners would be affected by altering the alignment of the 500kV transmission line recommended by the Line Siting Committee. I'm sure you are aware that there already exists a huge transmission line running through Magic Ranch; a transmission line that was there long before Magic Ranch was even a twinkle in the eye of it's developer a few years ago. Residents of Magic Ranch made a conscious choice

and bought their new homes under existing transmission lines. Commissioner Mayes' amendment would dramatically impact an existing development called Wild Horse Estates. This community is bordered by the railroad tracks crossing Felix Road and has 1.25-acre horse properties. There are at least 50 homes in this area and unlike the 70 residents at Oasis at Magic Ranch, they did not build their homes under an existing transmission line. In addition to the impacts on Wild Horse Estates, the railroad track alignment would seriously hamper Anthem, which is a big part of Florence's future.

Commissioner Gleason has a lofty goal in his alternative route taking advantage of the Central Arizona Project Canal. It would decrease the costs of construction and ultimately the price consumers have to pay for electricity. However Commissioner Gleason's amendment would bisect Sun Valley Farms, a 25 year old, 1 square mile community with 2.5-acre minimum parcels and light restrictions. Many of the Sun Valley Farms residents have their homes built right up against the CAP, which is considered an amenity. Since the CAP bisects Sun Valley Farms at a 45-degree angle, it would impose the maximum exposure (1.5 miles of transmission line) on the community. The trade-off would be permanent and highly concentrated costs on the quarter century old Sun Valley Farms for the few cents benefits to ratepayers. Equity considerations must be given weight in any cost savings algorithm.

The town of Florence is poised to develop our small community into something other than a "Prison Town." We have a four-year liberal arts college and a new hospital in the planning stages. Another big part of our dream is Anthem. A perfect alignment for this 500kV transmission line does not exist. The Committee has spent hours and hours listening to everybody's positions and determined the "best" alignment. I am grateful for your concern for Pinal County residents and ratepayers, however I would ask that you reconsider your position and support the recommendation of the Line Siting Committee.
