Dear Mr. Comblatt:

On February 19, 2003 Alticom, Inc. ("Alticom") filed an application for a CC&N to provide telecommunication services in the State of Arizona. This application was not sufficient and on February 26, 2003, a data request was issued to Alticom's consultant, Monica Haab or Nowalsky, Bronston and Gathard.

On March 11, 2003, and on May 1, 2003, the Commission received Alticom's responses to this data request. On May 23, 2003, Staff issued its second data request to Alticom's consultant, Ms. Haab. This data request was not answered and on August 14, 2003, it was resent to Ms. Haab. To date, Staff has not received a response to either its May 23, 2003 and August 14, 2003 data requests.

On September 4, 2004, Staff issued its third data request to Ms. Haab. To date, the Commission has not received a response to Staff's third data request.

On June 7, 2005, Staff attempted to contact Alticom at the phone number indicated in its application and received a message indicating that this telephone number "is no longer in service."

On August 23, 2005, Staff left a message with Ms. Haab asking her to indicate Alticom's status. On August 24, 2005, Ms. Haab contacted Staff via email and indicated that Alticom is no longer in business and that there is no need to proceed with this application. Ms. Haab also suggested the dismissal and/or revocation of this application.

If you wish to proceed in this matter, please contact Staff within **10 days** of the date of this letter. Mail an original plus 13 copies to Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 W. Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007-2927. If no response is received, Staff will recommend that this application be terminated. If the application is terminated, the Applicant cannot provide the same telecommunications services in Arizona for which it is currently applying, until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Commission.


