PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

1. On April 24, 2001, Coin Phone Management Company ("Coin") was ordered to file Fair Value Rate Base ("FVRB") information within 18 months of the date Coin first provides service to Arizona customers as a condition of Coin receiving its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone service in Decision No. 63605.
2. On May 17, 2001, Coin sent a letter to the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") that indicated that it first provided service to customers in Arizona on May 4, 2001.
3. On May 6, 2002, the Compliance Section of the Commission sent a letter of non-compliance to Coin. In the letter, the Compliance Section indicated that the Certificate did not issue to Coin and is void because of Coin's failure to file FVRB information with the Commission within 18 months of the date Coin first provided service to Arizona customers.
4. On May 17, 2002, Coin requested an extension of time to provide FVRB information. Staff did not object to Coin's request for an extension of time to file FVRB information.
5. On June 17, 2002, Coin provided the required FVRB information.
6. On July 9, 2002, Staff filed a Staff Report recommending that Coin be granted a 45 day retroactive extension to Coin to file its FVRB information. Staff further recommended that Coin be granted the extension without a hearing, and that all other provisions of Decision No. 63605 remain in effect as ordered.

1 7. In a review of this case, it appears that the letter of non-compliance was issued in
2 error. Pursuant to Decision No. 63605, Coin was ordered to file FVRB information within 18 months
3 of the date it first provided service to Arizona customers. Coin indicated that it first began providing
4 service to Arizona customers on May 4, 2001. Therefore, Coin had until November 4, 2002 to file its
5 FVRB information.

6 8. The Hearing Division consulted Staff and Staff agreed that since Coin filed its FVRB
7 information on June 17, 2002, it had complied with the provisions regarding the filing of FVRB
8 information in Decision No. 63605.

9 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Coin Phone Management Company's Certificate of
10 Convenience and Necessity to provide customer-owned pay telephone service, pursuant to Decision
11 No. 63605, remains in effect as Coin Phone Management Company has complied with the filing
12 requirement regarding information about its Fair Value Rate Base as ordered in Decision No. 63605.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that all other provisions in Decision No. 63605 remain in effect
14 as ordered.
