RE: COM-TECH SYSTEMS, DOCKET NO. T-03972A-00-1033, DECISION NO. 63607

On July 9, 2001, Com-Tech Systems ("Com-Tech") filed a request for a 45-day extension to file its fair value rate base ("FVRB").

Com-Tech notified the Commission that it began providing service to customers in Arizona on May 30, 1999. According to Decision No. 63607, Com-Tech was required to file their FVRB within 18 months from the date it begins providing service. Consequently, Com-Tech should have filed its FVRB no later than November 30, 2000. Staff finds Com-Tech System's request for an extension to be reasonable in order to keep the CC&N active.

Staff recommends that Com-Tech Systems be granted a 45-day extension to file their FVRB to the Compliance Manager. Also, Staff recommends that the extension of time should be 45 days from the effective date of the order granting this extension request and that all-remaining provisions of Decision No. 63607 remain in full force and effect.
