Dear Mr. McNeil,

On August 10, 1998, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("the Commission") granted MegsINET-CLEC, Inc. ("M-CLEC") a certificate of convenience and necessity (reference Docket No. T-03603A-0420 and Decision No. 61231) to offer intrastate toll services as a reseller in the State of Arizona.

Pursuant to a merger agreement, CoreComm Acquisition Sub., Inc. ("CAS"), a wholly-owned subsidiary of CoreComm Limited ("CoreComm"), has been merged with and into MegsINET, Inc., the direct parent company of M-CLEC. As a result of the merger, the separate corporate existence of CAS has ceased and CoreComm has acquired control of MegsINET, Inc. M-CLEC survives the merger as a wholly-owned subsidiary of MegsINET, Inc. Accordingly, CoreComm has acquired control of M-CLEC through its ownership of MegsINET, Inc.

M-CLEC has never had any customers, and has never provided telecommunications services, in Arizona. Thus, CoreComm will not request that the Commission transfer M-CLEC's certificate of convenience and necessity to provide intrastate services as a reseller, and respectfully requests that the Commission withdraw and cancel the same.
