STAFF'S RESPONSE TO
APPLICATIONS FILING
ARIZONA CORPORATION COMMISSION

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On July 14, 2000 CenturyTel Solutions, LLC (CTS) filed an application with the Arizona Corporation Commission (Commission) for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity (CC&N) to provide all forms of resold and facilities-based local exchange and exchange access telecommunications services throughout Arizona. On May 4, 2000 the Commission approved CTS' application contingent on several Staff-recommended conditions. In the May 4th order, CTS was required to file Compliance Tariff and 911 service information within 30 days of an Order in both matters.

On June 5, 2001, CTS requested additional time to comply with these particular requirements. For compliance, CTS claims it must first reach an interconnection agreement to finalize and file provisions of both 911 services and Compliance Tariffs. Per the Order, the Commission stipulated that CTS was to provide Directory and Directory Assistance plans within 30 days of an approval of an interconnection agreement. CTS claims that in order to finalize 911 services and Compliance Tariff information, it will need the Directory and Directory Assistance information. Therefore, CTS requests that the Commission allow CTS to provide the sum of this information within 30 days of an Order approving CTS' interconnection agreement, as opposed to 30 days within an order on the matters of the 911 services or Compliance Tariff information.

The Division has considered CTS' inability to provide 911 services and Tariff information without Directory and Directory Assistance information. Based CTS' circumstances and its full

1 intention to comply with Staff recommendations within 30 days prior to approval of an
2 interconnection agreement, Staff does not object to an extension of time for CTS to provide 911
3 service and final Tariff information to 30 days within the approval of an interconnection agreement.

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
