Dear Sir or Madam:

On behalf of CenturyTel Solutions, LLC ("CTS"), undersigned counsel, by this letter respectfully requests an extension of time to file information concerning CTS' provision of 911 service and CTS' final tariff with the Commission. By Opinion and Order in Commission Decision No. 63638 in Docket No. T-03902A-00-0509 ("Order") issued on May 4, 2001, CTS was authorized to provide competitive facilities-based and resold local exchange and access telecommunications services subject to certain Staff conditions, including CTS' filing of a compliance tariff and 911 service information. CTS needs additional time to make these compliance filings.

CTS will need to reach interconnection agreements before it can finalize its 911 plan and tariffs. Interconnection agreements address, among other things, Directory Assistance and provision of 911 service. Tariffing of services also requires information contained in interconnection agreements. The Commission has recognized that CTS' filing of its Directories and Directory Assistance Plan is conditioned on Commission approval of an interconnection agreement, and the Order permits CTS to file that information thirty (30) days after the Commission grants such approval. Before filing the 911 service information and final tariff, CTS will also need an approved interconnection agreement. Accordingly, CTS requests that the Commission allow CTS to file information concerning its provision of 911 service as well as its final tariff within 30 days of an Order approving CTS' interconnection agreement. CTS fully intends to comply with the Staff recommendations as set forth in the Order and simply needs additional time to make such compliance filings.
