**BY THE COMMISSION:**

Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

**FINDINGS OF FACT**

1. American Telco, Inc. has a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold interexchange telecommunications services in the State of Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 60231 (June 12, 1997).

2. On March 19, 2001, American Telco, Inc. filed with Docket Control of the Commission an application requesting cancellation of the Certificate.

3. American Telco, Inc. is no longer an operating company.

4. American Telco, Inc. does not serve any Arizona customers and therefore, no prepayments, advances, or deposits are at risk by the cancellation of the Certificate.

5. On April 5, 2001, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff Report recommending approval of American Telco, Inc.'s application for cancellation of its Certificate of Convenience and Necessity without a hearing.

6. Pursuant to Commission rules, the Commission may grant the application without a hearing.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

2 1. American Telco, Inc. is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV  
3 of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

4 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over American Telco, Inc. and the subject matter of  
5 the application.

6 3. The cancellation of American Telco, Inc.'s Certificate is in the public interest.

7 4. Staff's recommendation in Findings of Fact No. 5 is reasonable and should be  
8 adopted.

ORDER


