FINDINGS OF FACT




1. On September 10, 2003, Trico Electric Power Cooperative Inc., ("Trico") and Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP") filed a joint application that would allow TEP to serve property owned by Kimberly and Ian Poynton ("Poynton"), individuals, which is located within the certificated area of Trico.
2. Both TEP and Trico are engaged in providing electric service within portions of Pima County, Arizona, pursuant to authority granted by the Arizona Corporation Commission.
3. The Poynton property is located within Trico's certificated area. However, establishing service to the Poynton's property by Trico is difficult as Trico has been unable to obtain an easement for neighboring property to the west and other routes to Poynton's property involve crossing mountainous terrain.



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1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc., notify the Utilities
2 Division at least sixty days prior to providing service to the Poynton property.


