Hi Dennis & Julie: I am VERY concerned by a statement made by Heather Murphy, the commission's public information officer as quoted in the 8/24/ Herald article re ASUA waits for funds. "A date for the vote has not been set" - There will probably have to be an evidentiary hearing some time in September for a factual basis and sworn testimony on the need for a moratorium". The article then goes on to state that "while most of the corporation commissioners seem to support the moratorium, it still needs to go before the commission for a vote in an open meeting for final approval". Why is this taking so VERY LONG!

Would someone be able to tell me when and where this "evidentiary hearing" will be held? Will it be open to the public? Will it be announced in advance to give enough time for those of us truly concerned to attend and incur loss of work and wages, etc. to protect our health & safety! Do we need to hire a lawyer at this point for representation of the facts AGAIN! Will this "evidentiary hearing" be held before the public hearing by the ACC vote on the moratorium? Is someone trying to make the moratorium issue go away? Sure sounds that way to me. And what if it does? Something is dirty in Denmark and also right here in our own backyard!

Does any of this sound like someone does not believe the facts and information already presented? Are we being led down a primrose path here or what! What kind of "factual basis" can be presented? Do we need to submit pictures? Do the records not support the condition of the infrastructure? Does the number of residents speaking at the town hall meeting not count? Water connections with no meters! The list is endless and never ending as more broken water mains, incorrectly set timers, no storage tank delivered and hours without water continue.

I will be on vacation and out of town 8/28 thru 9/2 and I will be shutting my water off at the main. The amount of air in the pipes is unreal. I have heard a rumor that the excessive psi air pressure runs the meter just as actual water usage does. I urge you to get this information out to as many as possible. It may be necessary for us to unite and present a solid front at any public meeting. As for "sworn" testimony, maybe we can do this by deposition to protect ourselves, our quality of life and our property values. There must be some alternative for representation than having to take off work and travel to Phoenix! Maybe there is a legal beagle out there amongst us! I am really fed up with all of the STALLING!
