BY THE COMMISSION:

FINDINGS OF FACT

1. Tucson Electric Power Company ("TEP") is certificated to provide electric service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.

2. On May 10, 2002, TEP filed an application for approval of new Partial Requirements Service Tariffs, modification of existing partial requirements service tariff 101, and elimination of qualifying facility tariffs.

3. On June 5, 2002 (Decision No. 64868), the Commission suspended the application for 120 days, through October 7, 2002.

4. A Procedural Order, dated August 1, 2002, set this matter for a hearing to commence on October 22, 2002.

5. Staff has recommended that the application be suspended for an additional 180 days to accommodate the hearing process.

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CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

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2 1. TEP is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV, Section
3 2, of the Arizona Constitution.

4 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over TEP and over the subject matter of the
5 application.


6 3. The Commission, having reviewed the application and Staff's Memorandum dated
7 August 27, 2002, concludes that it is in the public interest to suspend the application for a period of
8 one hundred eighty (180) days.

9 ORDER

10 THEREFORE, IT IS ORDERED that the application be and hereby is suspended until and
11 including April 5, 2003.

12 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
