





11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

12 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
13 Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. On February 6, 2002, Scott Ferguson dba Cen-Tex Pay Telephone, Co., Inc.
16 ("Applicant") filed with the Commission an application for a Certificate of Convenience and
17 Necessity ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT") service in the State of
18 Arizona.

19 2. In Decision No. 55817 (December 10, 1987), the Commission found that COPT
20 providers were public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

21 3. In Decision No. 57797 (April 8, 1992), the Commission adopted A.A.C. R14-2-901
22 through R14-2-909 to regulate COPT providers.

23 4. Decision No. 58535 (February 14, 1994) adopted a Generic Tariff that establishes
24 rates and minimum service standards applicable to COPT service.

25 5. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue Decisions regarding COPT
26 Certificates without a hearing.

27 6. Applicant has requested that a Certificate be granted and has indicated that it will
28 provide COPT service pursuant to the rates, terms and conditions specified in the Generic COPT

1 Tariff.

2 7. Applicant does not presently provide COPT services in Arizona.

3 8. On April 2, 2002, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff
4 Report, recommending approval of the application without a hearing.

5 9. Staff stated that the Applicant has provided a copy of its customer information placard
6 in compliance with the Generic Tariff.

7 10. Staff also stated that increased pay telephone availability is in the public interest.

8 CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

9 1. Applicant is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the
10 Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.

11 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over Applicant and the subject matter of the
12 application.

13 3. The provision of COPT service in Arizona by Applicant is in the public interest.

14 4. Applicant is a fit and proper entity to receive a Certificate for providing COPT service
15 in Arizona.

16 5. Staff's recommendation in Findings of Fact No. 8 is reasonable and should be
17 adopted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.


