





11 BY THE COMMISSION:

12 FINDINGS OF FACT

13 1. Sulphur Springs Valley Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("SSVEC") is certificated to provide
14 electric service as a public service corporation in the State of Arizona.

15 2. On May 7, 2002, SSVEC filed an application for approval to freeze its tariffs, Schedules
16 GT, PT, and RT. Customers currently on the tariffs as of June 4, 2002, would be allowed to remain
17 on the tariffs. The tariffs would not be available for new customers after June 4, 2002.

18 3. Schedule GT (General Service & Small Power Time of Use), Schedule PT (General
19 Power Service Time of Use), and Schedule RT (Residential Time of Use) are experimental time-of-use
20 tariffs.

21 4. On March 25, 2002 (Decision No. 64654), the Commission approved revisions to the
22 tariffs. SSVEC has discovered that it made an error in determining the revised rates. Instead of
23 requesting more upward revisions of these rates at this time, SSVEC has proposed that the tariffs be
24 frozen.

25 5. Staff has recommended that the application be approved.

26 6. Staff has further recommended that SSVEC file tariff pages consistent with the terms of
27 this Decision within 15 days from the effective date of this Decision.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

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2 1. SSVEC is an Arizona public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV,
3 Section 2, of the Arizona Constitution.

4 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over SSVEC and over the subject matter of the
5 application.

6 3. The Commission, having reviewed the application and Staff's Memorandum dated May
7 16, 2002, concludes that it is in the public interest to approve the application.


ORDER

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9 IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Schedules GT, PT, and RT are frozen as of the effective
10 date of this decision.

11 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that SSVEC shall file tariff pages consistent with the terms of
12 this Decision within 15 days from the effective date of this Decision.

13 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
