11 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

12 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
13 Commission finds, concludes, and orders that:

14 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

15 1. On December 7, 2001, in Decision No. 61531, the Commission granted to Park 'N
16 View, Inc. a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity ("CC&N") authorizing it to provide
17 competitive interLATA/intraLATA resold telecommunications services except local exchange
18 services.

19 2. Effective October 6, 1999, Park 'N View Inc. changed its name to PNV.Net, Inc.
20 ("PNV").

21 3. On December 7, 2001, PNV filed in this docket an application requesting that the
22 Commission cancel its CC&N and release the surety bond on file with the Commission. The
23 application stated that PNV is in the process of bankruptcy and has no customers.

24 4. On January 14, 2002, the Commission's Utilities Division Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff
25 Report in this matter.

26 5. In the Staff Report, Staff stated that PNV is no longer doing business; does not service
27 any intrastate customers; and no prepayments, deposits, or advances would be at risk by cancellation
28 of PNV's CC&N.

- 6. Staff has indicated that it is not opposed to the release of PNV's surety bond.
- 7. There are numerous other carriers in Arizona offering services similar to those PNV is currently certificated to provide.
- 8. No Arizona customers will be affected by the requested cancellation.
- 9. In the Staff Report, Staff recommended approval of PNV's application, and further recommended that a hearing not be held.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. PNV is a public service corporation within the meaning of Article XV of the Arizona Constitution and A.R.S. §§ 40-281 and 40-282.
- 2. The Commission has jurisdiction over PNV and the subject matter of the application.
- 3. The cancellation of PNV's CC&N is in the public interest.
- 4. Staff's recommendation in Findings of Fact No. 9 is reasonable and should be adopted.
