On October 26, 2005, AmeriVon LLC ("AmeriVon") filed an Application and Petition for Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Provide Intrastate Telecommunications Services in the above-referenced matter. This data request lists the information Staff needs to complete its analysis of your application. Please treat this, as Staff's first set of data requests to AmeriVon.

For purposes of this data request set, the words "AmeriVon", "Applicant", "the Company", "you", and "your" refer to AmeriVon LLC and any representative, including every person and/or entity acting with, under the control of, or on behalf of AmeriVon LLC. For each answer, please identify by name, title, and address each person providing information that forms the basis for the response provided.

These data requests are continuing, and your answers or any documents supplied in response to these data requests should be supplemented with any additional information or documents that come to your attention after you have provided your initial responses.


Please provide Docket Control with the information being requested within 60 days of the date of this letter. Mail an original plus 13 copies to Docket Control, Arizona Corporation Commission, 1200 West Washington Street, Phoenix, AZ 85007-2927. If no response is received or all deficiencies are not remedied within 60 days, Staff will recommend that the application be terminated as per Rule R14-2-1103(B)3 and R14-2-510(E)3. If the application is terminated, the Applicant cannot provide the same telecommunications services in Arizona for which it is currently applying, until such time as a new application is filed with and approved by the Arizona Corporation Commission.

Please make sure each numbered item and each part of the item is answered completely. In order for Staff to continue with its review of this application, the following information must be submitted:

- STF 1.1 Please provide complete information as required by A-8.2 in the application, "A list of the names of all owners, partners, limited liability company managers (or if a member managed LLC, all members), or corporation officers and directors (specify)."
- STF 1.2 Please provide complete information as required by A-8.3 in the application, "Indicate percentages of ownership of each person listed in A-8.2."
- STF 1.3 Please provide complete information as required by A-9.1 to A-9.5
- STF 1.4 Please provide complete information as required by A-15
- STF 1.5 Please provide Attachment C as required by A-16 for resellers of long distance.
- STF 1.6 As requested by A-18, please confirm that AmeriVon has not been denied authority in any states to offer telecommunications services similar to those that the Applicant will or intends to offer in the State of Arizona, or please provide the names of states in which AmeriVon has been denied authority to offer telecommunications services similar to those that the Applicant will or intends to offer in the State of Arizona.
- STF 1.7 Per Applicant's answer to A-19, AmeriVon has authority or is seeking authority to provide telecommunications services in Washington, D.C. and all 50 states except Alaska, New York and Oklahoma. Please explain the exclusion of these states.
- STF 1.8 Please provide the decision number, and associated date, authorizing AmeriVon to provide service as a Long Distance Reseller in Utah, Washington, D.C. and Virginia.
- STF 1.9 Please clarify if AmeriVon LLC has any affiliates other than its parent, AmeriVon Holdings LLC.
- STF 1.10 The Certificate of Good Standing included in AmeriVon's application is from the state of Nevada. Please provide a Certificate of Good Standing in Arizona from the State of Arizona.
- STF 1.11 The tariff submitted in AmeriVon's application is not structured around maximum and actual rates. Does AmeriVon accept that its actual rates will also be considered maximum rates, necessitating that AmeriVon apply for maximum rate increases whenever AmeriVon proposes to increase actual rates?
