**APPLICATION OF SPRINT COMMUNICATIONS COMPANY L.P. TO  
TRANSFER ARIZONA COMPLETE SENSE CUSTOMERS (sm) AND  
DISCONTINUE THE PROVISION OF UNE-P SERVICE IN ARIZONA**

Under A.A.C. R14-2-1107, Sprint Communications Company L.P. requests  
Commission approval to allow Sprint to discontinue its tariffed Sprint Complete Sense (sm) and  
Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) product, an all-distance service offered through an  
unbundled network element platform (UNE-P); and, to transfer all Arizona Sprint Complete Sense  
(sm) and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) customers to Trinsic Communications, Inc.  
Sprint respectfully requests that the Commission approve this Application without hearing on such  
a timeline that Sprint may transfer its Arizona customers to Trinsic on or before February 1, 2006.

As noted below, Sprint is discontinuing UNE-P services because of changes in  
federal law. Sprint makes this request because its nationwide UNE-P withdrawal necessitates that  
the customer transfer take place on as similar a schedule as possible throughout the country so as  
to minimize customer confusion and customer impacts. Finally, Sprint requests a waiver to the  
extent necessary of any applicable anti-slamming regulations under A.A.C. R14-2-1901, *et. seq.*

1 that may be violated by the proposed transfer without the specific authorization and verification of  
2 each customer affected by the transaction.

3 **I. SUMMARY OF THE PROPOSED TRANSACTION.**

4 1. In this application, Sprint seeks Commission authority to discontinue  
5 providing Sprint Complete Sense (sm) and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) services  
6 offered through UNE-P to its Arizona customers and to transfer those Arizona customers to  
7 Trinsic subject to any tariff restrictions that may apply. Sprint currently serves 2,415 Complete  
8 Sense customers in Arizona with 2,582 lines.

9  
10 2. To maintain customer services relating to the transaction, Sprint has  
11 developed a customer notification and transfer plan intended to provide Arizona customers with  
12 clear information about Sprint's withdrawal from the Sprint Complete Sense (sm) and Sprint  
13 Complete Sense for Business (sm) market and the transfer of that customer base to Trinsic. The  
14 customer notice provided to customers by Sprint on December 2, 2005 is attached as Exhibit A,  
15 along with two additional notices to be provided to customers in January 2006. Those notices  
16 contain information advising Arizona customers about Sprint's discontinuance of UNE-P services  
17 and that customer services, rates, terms and conditions will be provided by Trinsic. In the notices,  
18 Sprint also advises customers how they may obtain additional information.

19  
20  
21 3. Arizona customers will not incur any costs as a result of the transfer and  
22 Sprint has advised customers that they have a choice of providers and may elect to switch their  
23 services to a provider other than Trinsic. Sprint's customer notification plan is intended to  
24 enhance customer choice and allow a seamless transition to another provider. Sprint has  
25 implemented its plan by sending customer notice letters to its subscriber base in Arizona. The  
26

1 notice letters comply with this Commission's customer notification rules and with the Federal  
2 Communications Commission's (FCC) customer notification rules.

3 **II. PARTIES.**

4 4. Sprint Communications Company, L.P. is a limited partnership created  
5 under the laws of Delaware with its principal place of business in Overland Park, Kansas. Sprint  
6 is authorized to provide local exchange and interexchange services on a facilities-based and resale  
7 basis in Arizona under Decision No. 60236. Sprint currently provides local exchange service and  
8 intra- and inter-LATA long distance service in Arizona. Sprint has provided competitive local  
9 exchange service in collaboration with Trinsic since February 1, 2003, and Sprint currently serves  
10 2,415 Complete Sense customers with 2,582 lines in Arizona. All Sprint Complete Sense service  
11 offerings are provided out of Sprint's current tariffs on file with the Commission and no services  
12 are provided on a contractual basis.

15 5. Trinsic Communications, Inc. is a certificated competitive local exchange  
16 carrier in Arizona. Z-Tel Communications, Inc. received its certificate from the ACC on  
17 September 18, 2000 in Decision No. 62896. Z-Tel changed its name to Trinsic Communications  
18 as approved by the Commission on February 2, 2005 in Docket No. T-03589A-04-0873. In  
19 conjunction with Sprint's withdrawal from the UNE-P market, Sprint engaged in discussions and  
20 has finalized contract negotiations with Trinsic relating to providing service to Sprint's Complete  
21 Sense customers. On the basis of those discussions, Trinsic has agreed to accept all Sprint  
22 Complete Sense customers who elect to be automatically transferred to Trinsic. After such  
23 transfer, Trinsic has agreed to provide the same services to those customers at the same prices,  
24 under the same terms, as the services were provided by Sprint. Trinsic has been advised of and  
25 fully approves this application.

**III. REASON FOR DISCONTINUANCE OF SERVICE BY SPRINT.**

6. As explained herein, Sprint has decided to withdraw from the provision of its Sprint Complete Sense (sm) and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) product which, in part, is offered through UNE-P because of changes in federal law. Sprint will continue to offer stand-alone inter- and intra-LATA long distance services and may in the future modify its competitive local exchange service strategy for Arizona.

7. Sprint has been in the local market utilizing UNE-P since 2003. Currently, Sprint has a total of 157,595 customers on this service nationwide. In March 2004, the D.C. Circuit Court of Appeals issued a stay relating to the Federal Communications Commission's Triennial Review Order which ordered the combining of UNEs.<sup>1</sup> Consistent with the decision of the D.C. Circuit Court, the FCC, in its Triennial Review Remand Order released in February 2005, adopted new rules for network unbundling obligations of incumbent local exchange carriers.<sup>2</sup> The new FCC rules, which became effective March 11, 2005, provide that within 12 months, UNE-P services are no longer legally compelled from ILECs. As a result of the new FCC rules, it is no longer economically feasible for Sprint to continue providing these services and Sprint has decided to exit the UNE-P business.

1                   8.       Although Sprint no longer wishes to pursue a UNE-P strategy, Sprint has  
2 confidence that customers who opt to transfer to Trinsic will find the transfer to be transparent and  
3 will continue to receive the same excellent level of service as provided by Sprint.

4                   **IV. VERIFICATION OF CUSTOMER NOTICE AND ACCESS TO ALTERNATIVE**  
5                   **PROVIDERS.**

6                   9.       In an effort to serve the public interest relating to the proposed transfer of  
7 Sprint Complete Sense (sm) and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) customers, Sprint has  
8 developed and implemented a customer notification plan. Under this plan, Sprint has and will  
9 provide Arizona customers with the notification letters attached as exhibit A informing them of  
10 Sprint's application to withdraw from the local market and describing how customers will be  
11 affected by Sprint's proposed withdrawal. In these notice letters, Sprint has informed customers of  
12 the transition to Trinsic as well as the customer's rights to select a new provider other than Trinsic.  
13 Finally, Sprint has informed customers that they can decide to be automatically transitioned to  
14 Trinsic on or before February 1, 2006 if they choose not to change to another provider prior to  
15 Sprint's exit from the local market.  
16

17                   10.       As noted above, Sprint has engaged in discussions and has finalized  
18 contract negotiations with Trinsic relating to providing service to Sprint Complete Sense (sm)  
19 customers. On the basis of those discussions, Trinsic has agreed to accept all Sprint customers  
20 who elect to be automatically transferred to Trinsic. After the transferred customers become  
21 customers of Trinsic, they will receive the same services at the same prices, under the same terms,  
22 as the services were provided by Sprint. In fact, Trinsic's tariff mirrors the Sprint Complete Sense  
23 (sm) and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) tariff. Trinsic is willing and able to provide  
24 service to Sprint Complete Sense (sm) customers on the same terms and conditions as Sprint.


1 the proposed transfer without the specific authorization and verification of each customer affected  
2 by this proposed transaction. The Commission's waiver of the slamming rules in this matter will  
3 serve the public interest and Sprint has provided customers with ample notice of the company's  
4 withdrawal from the UNE-P market in Arizona.

5 **VIII. CONCLUSION.**

6  
7 Sprint requests and urges the Commission to approve this Application without  
8 hearing as expeditiously as possible. Sprint's withdrawal from the Sprint Complete Sense (sm)  
9 and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) market is nationwide. Towards that end, Sprint is in  
10 the process of notifying customers in other states of its decision to terminate its Sprint Complete  
11 Sense (sm) and Sprint Complete Sense for Business (sm) service offerings. As a result, it is  
12 important that the Commission approve this Application as quickly as possible and without  
13 hearing to allow Sprint to serve the public interest by transferring its customers to Trinsic on or  
14 about February 1, 2006.
