PROCEDURAL ORDER

BY THE COMMISSION:

14 On June 27, 2000, ServiSense.com, Inc. ("Applicant") filed with Docket Control of the
15 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience
16 and Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold local exchange and interexchange
17 telecommunications services within the State of Arizona.

18 On March 2, 2001, Commission Staff ("Staff") filed a Staff Report recommending approval
19 of ServiSense.com, Inc.'s application subject to a number of conditions.

20 Pursuant to Commission rules, Applicant is required to publish notice of its filing in
21 newspapers in all counties where service is to be provided. The record shows that Applicant has not
22 filed a Notice of Filing Affidavits of Publication that would indicate compliance with the publishing
23 requirement.

24 Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may act on an application for a Certificate to
25 provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a hearing if one is requested
26 by any party.

27 The time frame for processing this application expires on March 28, 2001.

28 Pursuant to Commission rules, the Commission now issues this Procedural Order to govern
the preparation and conduct of this proceeding.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the time frame for processing this application shall be
extended until June 29, 2001 to allow ServiSense.com, Inc. additional time to publish notice.

1 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ServiSense.com, Inc. shall file written exceptions to the
2 Staff Report or request that a hearing be set by May 23, 2001.

3 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C. R14-2-105,
4 except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before May 23, 2001.

5 IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that ServiSense.com, Inc. shall publish notice, as stated below,
6 in newspapers in every county in Arizona in which ServiSense.com, Inc. desires to provide service by
7 **May 2, 2001:**

8 **NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A CERTIFICATE**
9 **OF CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY TO PROVIDE COMPETITIVE RESOLD**
10 **LOCAL EXCHANGE AND INTEREXCHANGE TELECOMMUNICATIONS**
11 **SERVICES BY SERVISSENSE.COM, INC.**

12 ServiSense.com, Inc. ("Applicant") has filed with the Arizona Corporation
13 Commission ("Commission") an application for a Certificate of Convenience and
14 Necessity ("Certificate") to provide competitive resold local exchange and interexchange
15 telecommunications services in the State of Arizona. Applicant will be required by the
16 Commission to provide this service under the rates and charges and terms and conditions
17 established by the Commission.

18 A.R.S. § 40-282 provides that the Commission may act on an application for a
19 Certificate to provide resold telecommunications services without a hearing, or with a
20 hearing, if one is requested by any party. Applicant or any other party must request a
21 hearing by May 23, 2001, or the Commission will rule on the application without a
22 hearing.

23 The application, report of the Commission's Utilities Division Staff, and any
24 written exceptions to the staff report prepared by the applicant are available for
25 inspection during regular business hours at the offices of the Commission located at 1200
26 West Washington Street, Phoenix, Arizona 85007, and at Applicant, [address].

27 Under appropriate circumstances, interested parties may intervene in the
28 proceedings and participate as a party. Intervention shall be in accordance with A.A.C.
R14-3-105, except that all motions to intervene must be filed on or before May 23, 2001.
You may have the right to intervene in the proceeding, or you may make a statement for


