In the matter of the Application of ServiSense.com, Inc. for a Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to Provide Competitive Intrastate Telecommunication Service:

- This application is complete.

1. An actual tariff for each service to be provided that states the maximum rate as well as the initial price to be charged, and that also states other terms and conditions that will apply to provision of the service by the telecommunications company.

R14-2-1104(E), the Applicant is required to publish legal notice of the application in all counties where services will be provided no later than 20 days after the application is filed. The Applicant must file with the Commission copies of the affidavits of publication for each newspaper in which public notice in this matter was published. If the affidavits are not filed with the Commission in a timely manner, your application may be terminated. In addition, please see A.A.C. R14-2-1104(A)(3) which requires that the Applicant submit a tariff with both **maximum** rates, along with the **actual** rate to be charges.
