12 **BY THE COMMISSION:**

13 Having considered the entire record herein and being fully advised in the premises, the
14 Arizona Corporation Commission ("Commission") finds, concludes, and orders that:

15 **FINDINGS OF FACT**

16 1. Uplink Payphones, LLC. ("Applicant") has a Certificate of Convenience and
17 Necessity ("Certificate") to provide customer-owned pay telephone ("COPT") service in the State of
18 Arizona pursuant to Decision No. 60001 (January 27, 1997).

19 2. On October 10, 2000, Applicant filed with Docket Control of the Commission an
20 application for approval for the sale of assets and the cancellation of the Certificate.

21 3. In Decision No. 55817 (December 10, 1987), the Commission found that COPT
22 providers were public service corporations subject to the jurisdiction of the Commission.

23 4. Decision No. 57797 (April 8, 1992) adopted A.A.C. R14-2-901 through R14-2-909 to
24 regulate COPT providers.

25 5. Decision No. 58535 (February 14, 1994) adopted a Generic Tariff that establishes
26 rates and minimum service standards applicable to COPT service.

27 6. Pursuant to A.R.S. § 40-282, the Commission may issue Decisions regarding COPT
28 Certificates without a hearing.

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ORDER

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the application of Uplink Payphones, LLC for the sale of assets and the cancellation of the Certificate of Convenience and Necessity to provide customer-owned pay telephone service shall be, and is hereby, approved.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that this Decision shall become effective immediately.
